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

### Short particulars of all the property mortgaged or charged

- 1. All freehold and leasehold property of the Company both present and future together with all buildings and fixtures (including trade fixtures) and fixed plant and machinery from time to time thereon and therein (but excluding landlords' fixtures).
- 2. All plant, machinery, vehicles and other equipment at the date of the Guarantee and Debenture or thereafter owned by the Company together with the benefit of any obligations and warranties given by the manufacturer or supplier of such plant, machinery or other equipment and the benefit of all maintenance agreements entered into between the Company and any other person in respect of such plant, machinery and other equipment.
- 3. All shares and stock in the capital of any company which as at the date of the Guarantee and Debenture or at any time thereafter is owned by the Company or in which the Company otherwise has an interest together in all cases with all rights arising in relation thereto.
- 4. The benefit of all present and future licences (statutory or otherwise) held in connection with the business of the Company or the user of any of the mortgaged property and the right to recover and receive all compensation which may at any time become payable to it in respect thereof.
- 5. All licences and patents (including applications and the rights to apply therefor), copyrights, rights in trademarks whether registered or not, trade names, rights in service marks whether registered or not,

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registered designs, know-how and rights in confidential information at the date of the Guarantee and Debenture or at any time belonging to the Company.

- 6. The goodwill and the uncalled capital of the Company both present and future.
