Auditors' report to the directors of Bals Engineering Group Limited pursuant to Section 156(4) of the Companies Act 1985

We have examined the attached statutory declaration of the directors of Bals Engineering Group Limited ('the Company') dated 13 March 2000 in connection with the proposal that the Company's subsidiary undertaking, Bals Electrical Engineering Limited, should give financial assistance for the purchase of 53,345 cumulative convertible preferred ordinary shares of £1 each and 395,592 ordinary shares of ten pence each of the ordinary shares of the Company.
