### Notes to the Accounts for the year ended 31st May 2022

#### 1. Accounting Policies

- 1.1. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective January 2015)
- 1.2. Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost or valuation less residual value of each asset over its expected useful life, as follows:

**Club Freehold Premises** 

Over remaining life of lease - to 2079.

Fixtures & Fittings

15% on Reducing Balance

Rugby equipment & Lights -

15% on Reducing Balance

- 1.3. Stock is valued at cost and is readily realisable at the stated figure.
- 1.4. Receivables and payables are basic financial instruments held at cost less any bad debt provision.
- 1.5. As a mutual membership organisation corporation tax is only charged on income received from non-members.
- 1.6. Income and Expenditure reflected in the Accounts has been shown net of Value Added Tax payable or receivable
- 1.7. Assets obtained under hire purchase contracts are capitalised as tangible assets and depreciated over their useful lives. Obligations under such agreements are included in creditors net of the finance charge allocated to future periods.

#### 2. Directors' Responsibilities

The Directors are required to prepare financial statements for each financial period which give a true and fair view of the state of affairs of the company as at the end of the financial period and of the income and expenditure for that period. In preparing those financial statements, the Directors are required to:

- \* Select suitable accounting policies and then apply them consistently;
- \* Make judgements and estimates that are reasonable and prudent;
- \* Prepare the financial statements on the going concern basis, unless it is inappropriate to presume that the company will continue.

The Directors are responsible for keeping adequate accounting records which disclose with reasonable accuracy at any time the financial position of the company and to enable it to ensure that the financial statements comply with statutory requirements. It is also responsible for safeguarding the assets of the Club and hence for taking reasonable steps for the prevention of fraud and other irregularities.

The Directors confirm that as far as they are aware, there is no relevant audit information of which the club's auditors are unaware. They have taken all the steps that ought to have been taken in order to make themselves aware of any relevant audit information and to establish that the club's auditors are aware of that information.
