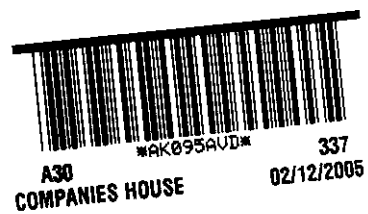

The directors of the company at 31 March 2005 are listed below:




For the year ended 31st March 2005 the company was entitled to exemption under section 249AA(1) of the Companies Act 1985.
