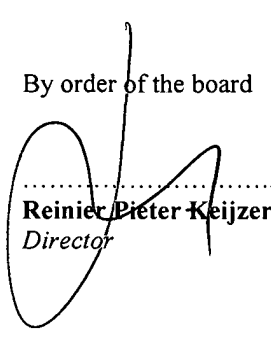

Under applicable law the directors are also responsible for preparing a Directors' Report that complies with that law.

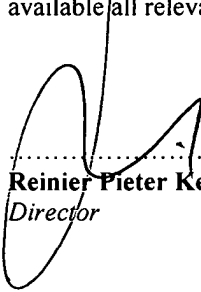
