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

DIRECTORS REPORT

The directors submit their report and the financial statements of the Charity for the year ended 31 March 1997.

RESULTS FOR YEAR

The balance of expenditure over income of £17,632 is the planned result of financing approved grants and guarantees and the cost of Fen Fever. The accumulated surplus at the year end of £252 reflects sound planning in the allocation and utilisation of funds available to ADeC, including the surplus funds brought forward from last year.

The creditors figure of £27,135 includes approved grants of £22,887 which had not been taken up at the year end.

REVIEW OF THE BUSINESS

The company's principal activity during the year was that of the promotion and development of the arts in East Cambridgeshire.

The directors consider the state of affairs at the year end to be satisfactory and are delighted that, under the auspices of ADeC, the take up of funds for the arts in East Cambridgeshire has become an established feature of artistic activity in the District.

FUTURE DEVELOPMENTS AND EVENTS SINCE THE END OF THE YEAR

The directors anticipate no significant change in the company's activities in the foreseeable future. There have been no events since the end of the year which require comment by the directors.

1 ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Accounting convention and standards

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention in accordance with applicable statements of standard accounting practice and financial reporting standards.

Turnover

Turnover represents income derived by direct grants from East Cambs District Council and others, subscriptions, box office and miscellaneous sales and is stated net of value added tax.

Depreciation

Depreciation is provided on all tangible fixed assets at rates calculated to write off the cost, less estimated residual value, of each asset over over its estimated useful life as follows:

Fixtures and fittings

15% per annum on the reducing balance

Taxation

The company, as a charity is not liable for assessment to tax on its results.

Leasing and hire purchase commitments

Rentals paid under operating agreements are charged to income as incurred. There were no finance leases or hire purchase agreements in operation during the period.
