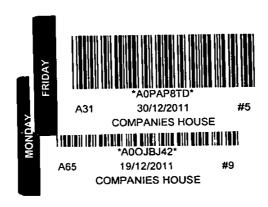

Independent Examiners' Report on the Accounts of the Management Committee of Christchurch Citizens Advice Bureau.

We report on the Accounts of the Company for the year ended 31 March 2011 which are set out on pages 4 to 10 from the accounting records and from information and explanations supplied to us by the management of the Company

Respective Responsibilities of the Management Committee and Examiners

d Taxation

Being a registered chanty, the Company is exempt from Corporation Tax under Section 505 of the Income and Corporation Tax Act 1998
