JOINT ADMINISTRATORS' PROPOSALS AND RESOLUTIONS

The Administrators' proposals in relation to the Company are:

- 1 The Administrators should continue to explore the possibility of selling the Company's assets upon the terms they consider to be the most beneficial to creditors of the Company.
- 2 The Administrators should arrange to distribute available funds from the realised assets to those creditors entitled to them in such manner as they consider will lead to an early distribution of the available assets in an economic manner.
- 3 The Administrators be authorised to make such application to court for directions as they consider appropriate with a view to achieving the purposes of the Administration or their proposals
4. The Administrators conclude the Administration when all the property and asset realisations have been completed (as far as possible) and distributed (after costs).
- 5 The Company exits the Administration by way of dissolution
