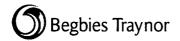

#### 4. CIRCUMSTANCES GIVING RISE TO OUR APPOINTMENT

#### Trading History - Initial Formation

Worcester Rugby Football Club ("the Club") dates back to 1871 when it was formed by the cleric Reverend Francis John Eld. The first recorded game of rugby football took place on 8 November 1871 against the Worcester Artillery at Somerset Place.

In 1893 the Club moved to Pitchcroft at New Road and a field adjoining Worcestershire County Cricket Club. Unfortunately, the club was disbanded in 1896. In 1908 the Club was revived and played matches at Pitchcroft and Northwick with the last game before the onset of World War I being played in 1913 against the Gloucester. Franciscans.

The Club was reformed following the end of World War I with a number of new players being recruited from Malvern, Droitwich, Pershore and Bromyard which resulted in the creation of the A and B teams. The Club continued to grow during the 1920s, playing in the traditional colours of narrow band yellow on blue.

During the 1920s the Club was lucky to have several players with first-class rugby experience which, with the support of the community, resulted in its strong performances through to the 1930s. Unfortunately, the Club began to experience problems with their grounds and, as a result, it had to move from various playing sites. The Club subsequently negotiated and paid a deposit on their own grounds opposite the Ketch Inn in Kempsey. However, when World War II broke out in 1939, the Club lost its deposit.

The ongoing war made regular matches difficult to organise and the Club eventually ceased to play until 1945. Following the disappointment of the loss of the grounds in Kempsey, the Club secured land at Claines and the first game was played there in November 1945.

The following year, bad weather prevented a full season from being played and the Club moved to new premises by the canal at Perdiswell. That season also saw the formation of a "Ground Purchase and Development Fund". At the end of the 1940s, the location of the Club changed again with the headquarters moving to the Old Talbot Hotel in Sidbury and the home ground to Bilford Road.

The Club, now settled at home on Bilford Road and, with a series of successful seasons, the decision was made to try and improve the facilities which resulted in a shed being purchased to serve as a players' cloakroom and shelter.

In 1956, the Club purchased its first grounds in Bevere and it continued to play with a strong side into the 1960s with five senior teams and two colts teams competing to a high level.

The Club entered the 1970s in a strong position and continued to play at Bevere for the early part of the 1970s before a move was secured to its current location at Sixways Stadium with the official opening of the new premises taking place on 4 September 1975.

The Club entered the 1980s eager to build on its growing stature from the previous decades and it enjoyed great success on both sides of the Atlantic, with unprecedented success throughout the 1990s as it moved up the league.

In 1992 the Club had plans to develop and construct a training shed to provide facilities for young rugby players in the youth and mini category. David Hallmark, the then Chairman, and in consultation with North Midlands Rugby Football Union, made an application for a much more sophisticated facility which was made by the Sports Council in 1995. It was at this point that the decision was made to incorporate as a limited company and this was done on 15 February 1996 with Roger Murray and Donald Everton being appointed as Directors along with a number of corporate Directors.

Most crucially, the decade saw the arrival of Cecil Duckworth who was able to drive the Club forward thanks to his significant investment. It was Mr Duckworth who supported the Lottery bid that saw a grant of £1.3million

awarded to the Club. With his guidance, the Club enjoyed huge success, changing beyond all recognition in the space of a few years.

National Division Five and Four were conquered and in 1997 the Club again won promotion to Jewson One. Promotion to Allied Dunbar Premier Division Two followed in the 1999/2000 season – before the division was renamed the First Division.

When the game went professional in 1996, Duckworth decided that if the Club was going to be successful it also had to be a professional club. Whilst the Club lost out on promotion to the very highest level at the first attempt it was eventually promoted to the Premiership in the 2003 / 2004 season after winning the title with a perfect record of 26 wins from 26 games. The Club faced a number of relegations and promotions since the 2003 / 2004 season but in recent years, with a strong team and the support of key investors, it maintained its position in the Premiership.

#### The reasons for the Company's insolvency

By 2018 the Club had established itself as an English Premiership rugby club. In addition, the Club had worked to maximise revenue by expanding the range of services offered to include conference, banqueting and hospitality services.

Its shareholder at the time, Sixways Holdings Limited ("Sixways"), had hoped to develop the Club's infrastructure to ultimately make it self-sustaining with the aim of returning the Club back to the community. Unfortunately, the shareholder was unable to achieve this objective.

Having invested approximately £30 million to develop the Club, it found itself in a unique position as the freehold owner of over 50 acres of land comprising both the rugby facilities and a conferencing and event facility.

Interest in the purchase of the Company's shares was received from Gerard McCory and Michael Blood in 2018 by way of a newly incorporated purchasing vehicle, Militibus Quanco Ltd ("Militibus"). Gerard McCory was appointed as the sole Director of Militibus on 21 February 2018.

A proposal for the purchase of the shares was put forward to the Rugby Football Union ("RFU"). However, the purchasers required additional funding of £2million to complete on the purchase. An offer to provide the required funds was provided by Colin Goldring and Jason Wittingham in exchange for 50% of the shares in Militibus. The sale subsequently completed on 28 September 2018.

The terms of the sale were as follows:

- Payment on completion of £1.
- Undertaking to pay £6,500,000 in respect of the loan owed by the Company to Sixways Holdings Limited (the Company's parent company) on behalf of the Company.
- Undertaking to pay the Duckworth Worcestershire Trust Loan of £500,000 to the Duckworth Worcestershire Trust.

Gerard McCory and Michael Blood were appointed as Directors of the Company on 28 September 2018 with Colin Goldring and Jason Wittingham also being appointed on 17 October 2018.

CVC Capital Partners ("CVC"), having already invested significantly in Premiership rugby, made further payments to teams in the league and the Company received £12,532,434.76 on 29 March 2019. A large proportion of these funds were used to pay windfall agreements. The position between the above parties shortly became untenable and Colin Goldring and Jason Wittingham purchased Gerard McCory and Michael Blood's interest in the Company. The latter both resigned as Directors on 11 June 2019.

Given the losses incurred by the Company in recent years, the decision was made to seek additional funding and discussions commenced with T3 Capital Limited ("T3"). A loan offer was subsequently received for £15m which was expected to provide the Company with sufficient working capital to bring it to the point of breaking even. However, the loan offer was withdrawn following the commencement of the Covid-19 pandemic and associated restrictions.

The Directors have advised that the start of the Company's substantive financial issues, and the root cause of the eventual failure, was the Covid-19 pandemic, the national lockdowns and the changes to the country's economic landscape coming out of the pandemic. The Directors reviewed the Company's insurance cover with the view to making a claim for business interruption. However, the Company's insurers rejected the Business Interruption Claim and no payment was made.

With the cancellation of all sporting and non-sporting events following Government-imposed restrictions, the Company suffered cashflow issues during the pandemic and was unable to pay its debts as and when they fell due.

Covid-19 and the related lockdowns placed an immense pressure on the business, draining it of all cash reserves and the build-up of a significant tax liability while the Company was unable to generate revenue from the stadium, whether rugby related or otherwise.

The Company applied for and received the benefit of a substantial Covid-19 loan of £11.49m from the Department for Design, Culture, Media and Sport ("DCMS"). As security for that loan, the Company granted a fixed and floating charge in favour of DCMS on 19 February 2021, and DCMS advanced the funds to the Company in June 2021. DCMS subsequently made further loans to the Company, such that the amount owing to DCMS as at the date of the Administrators' appointment was £16,134,720.40, comprising principal debt of £15,706,000.00 and interest of £428,720.40 (excluding DCMS' enforcement costs, which are recoverable under the terms of the fixed and floating charge).

The Directors entered into discussions with Macquarie Group Limited ("Macquarie") with a view to obtaining a cashflow loan facility, which the Directors hoped would assist with the Company's cashflow difficulties. Whilst the Company obtained credit approval, and the facility was due to complete imminently, the following events occurred which caused Macquarie to revoke its approval:

- By July 2022, the Company had significant arrears with a number of its suppliers, and during July 2022 a creditor issued a winding up petition against the Company (although the petition was withdrawn after the Company paid the amounts owing to the petitioning creditor in full).
- The Company's poor cashflow position meant that it was a week late with a VAT payment of £320,000.00 to HM Revenue & Customs ("HMRC"). Following the late payment, HMRC demanded repayment in full of all outstanding arrears (which included certain tax liabilities which had been deferred during the Covid-19 pandemic). The Company was unable to pay the amounts demanded and on 15 August 2022, HMRC issued a winding up petition against the Company.

The Administrators are informed that, following the events referred to above, the Directors entered into discussions with a potential purchaser of the Company's business and assets. The prospective purchaser confirmed it was prepared to pay the debts of the Company in full, however, the sale did not proceed as the prospective purchased was unable to obtain the funding necessary to operate the club, including funds needed to fund wages and insurance costs. As a result, the Company was suspended by the RFU from playing rugby matches.

The Administrators are also informed that, following HMRC issuing the winding up petition against the Company, the Directors continued to seek out prospective purchasers of the Company's business and assets, so as to avoid the possibility of the Company being placed into administration. The Company raised additional short-term finance from third party financers which was used to pay critical creditors and to delay any administration in the hope of completing a sale of the business and assets to a prospective purchaser.

The Administrators understand from their review of the Company's books and records that the Company continued to trade following the presentation of HMRC's winding-up petition, while the Directors pursued a deal with a prospective purchaser. However, no sale of the business or Company eventuated.

DCMS, as a secured creditor of the Company, was closely monitoring the Company's financial position from about February 2022 (discussed in further detail below) and, following a request from the Directors in September 2022 exercised its powers under the fixed and floating charge to appoint the Administrators as Administrators of the Company in accordance with paragraph 12 of the Act. For completeness, the Directors' proceeded to request that DCMS exercise its powers to appoint Administrators to the Company as the Directors were unable to appoint Administrators using the 'out of court' route due to the existence of HMRC's extant winding up petition against the Company.

On 27 September 2022, Julie Anne Palmer, Julian Pitts and Andrew Hook of Begbies Traynor (Central) LLP consented to act as proposed Administrators of the Company and we were appointed as Joint Administrators on that same day. On 27 September 2022, the Administrators were also appointed as Joint Receivers of the Sixways Stadium. On 5 October 2022, the Administrators were also appointed as

Joint Receivers over certain assets of Worcester Sports Limited, including the entire issued share capital of MQ Property Co Limited ("MQ Property"), following which the Joint Receivers exercised their powers to replace the incumbent directors of MQ Property with an independent director.

These actions were taken to improve the Administrators' ability to affect a sale of the Club's key assets, in order to increase the likelihood of the Club being sold as a going concern.

#### **Extent of our Involvement Prior to our Appointment**

Around February 2022, Julie Anne Palmer of Begbies Traynor (Central) LLP was contacted by DCMS for advice on DCMS's position as a secured creditor of the Company (and the wider group of companies).

Begbies Traynor was formally instructed by DCMS on 23 February 2022 to provide a strategic report on the options available. Having conducted a review of the position, it was noted that:

- the Club was loss making prior to the COVID-19 pandemic, and the funding provided by DCMS had not resolved the underlying issues concerning the Club's financial viability;
- the Club would be unable to pursue any of the options available to it (discussed in further detail below) unless it obtained additional funding, either from DCMS or other external sources;
- DCMS should assess whether and at what stage it would be prepared to take any enforcement action or commence an insolvency process; and
- any new owners of the Club would need to satisfy all applicable RFU diligence requirements, so
  early and regular consultation with the RFU and other key stakeholders would be necessary in
  order to avoid delays in a sale or enforcement scenario.

The following options were discussed with DCMS:

- Entry into an informal arrangement with creditors: This option was discounted because DCMS, as a secured creditor, would be unable to control this procedure and would therefore be reliant on the cooperation of the Company's Directors and the willingness of the Company's other creditors to enter into such an arrangement;
- Part A1 Moratorium: This option was discounted because although a moratorium would provide the Company with temporary relief from creditor action, it would not deliver a solution to Company's deteriorating financial position;
- Consensual Business Sale: It was recognised that this option could take a significant period
  of time, including to allow interested parties to complete due diligence and for the parties to
  negotiate and agree the transaction documents. Similarly, this option would require RFU
  approval, as any prospective purchaser would need to satisfy all applicable RFU diligence
  requirements.
- Company Voluntary Arrangement: This option was discounted as it was considered unlikely that HMRC, as secondary preferential creditor, would compromise its debt. Without HMRC support, it was considered unlikely that any arrangement could be implemented.
- Scheme of Arrangement: This option was discounted as schemes of arrangement are typically complex and expensive to implement, and must be approved by each class of creditors.
- Restructuring Plan: This option was discounted as the process is perceived as being complex and expensive and, although approval from each class of creditor is not necessarily required, the funds available to implement a restructuring plan were limited, particularly as the business' cashflow position was continuing to deteriorate.

- Administrators: This was ultimately considered to be the most appropriate option as notwithstanding that it would trigger certain sanctions from the RFU, it offered the most expedient and efficient way of securing control of the Company and its assets, and the greatest chances of maximising returns to creditors.
- Compulsory Liquidation: This was considered to be the least attractive option as based on Begbies Traynor's analysis, it would yield the lowest return for DCMS and other creditors.

Begbies Traynor were subsequently re-engaged by DCMS to provide further advice in relation to the potential outcomes for DCMS, in the event of the insolvency of the Club. Various indicative but realistic scenarios were prepared and discussed with DCMS, together with estimated outcome statements. This work allowed DCMS to internally prepare for an insolvency in the event that the proposed external funding was not obtained by the Club.

For the avoidance of any doubt, all work undertaken by Begbies Traynor prior to the Administration was solely for DCMS and not the Company. Limited information was provided by the Company directly, as Begbies Traynor's engagement was directly with DCMS.

#### STATEMENT OF AFFAIRS

The Joint Administrators' have prepared a draft Statement of Affairs for the Directors' approval but we are yet to receive their comments. Therefore, our draft Statement of Affairs is enclosed at Appendix 2. It should be noted that the statement of affairs makes no provision for the costs of the administration. Note that the draft Statement of Affairs was prepared prior to accepting an offer for the business and assets (subject to contract).

Our comments on the statement of affairs are as follows:

#### **FIXED CHARGE ASSETS**

#### P Shares & Fixed Interest Stocks

The Company's management accounts as at 30 June 2022 record that the Company had allocated a book value of £13,865,000.00 to the P Shares (issued by PRL Investor Limited ("PRL")) and other Fixed Interest Stocks.

These shares are subject to pre-emptive rights, the terms of which are set out in the relevant Shareholders' Agreements and which remain confidential. We are currently liaising with the PRL as to whether any parties intend to exercise such pre-emptive rights, but are yet to receive confirmation. Therefore, the estimated to realise value is "uncertain" for the purposes of the Statement of Affairs.

#### PRL Payment

The Company received monthly payments from PRL. However, the PRL is withholding amounts due to the Company on the basis that the Company owes certain amounts to the PRL. It is not yet clear whether PRL is legally entitled to set-off the amounts it is owed by the Company against amounts it owes to the Company. Discussions between the Administrators and the PRL are ongoing in this respect.

For the purposes of the Statement of Affairs, the estimated to realise value of the PRL distributions is "uncertain".

#### **SECURED CREDITOR**

The Company granted the English Sports Council a fixed charge on 17 February 2021 over the Company's P Shares in PRL and its invested units in Premier Rugby Limited. The charge was registered at Companies House on the same day.

The English Sports Council was also granted a floating charge on 17 February 2021 over the Company's other assets and undertakings which are not subject to the fixed charge. The floating charge was also registered on the same day.

As at the date of our appointment, the amount owing by the Company to DCMS was £16,134,720.40, comprising principal debt of £15,706,000.00 and interest of £428,720.40, but excluding enforcement and other costs recoverable by DCMS under its fixed and floating charge.

#### **FLOATING CHARGE ASSETS**

#### Goodwill

The Company's accounts do not allocate any value to the Company's goodwill. The estimated to realise amount in the Statement of Affairs is uncertain as we are yet to agree how the consideration payable by the preferred purchaser for the sale of the Company's business and assets shall be apportioned across the various categories of assets.

Eddisons Commercial Limited ("Eddisons") has undertaken a valuation of the Company's goodwill and estimated that, as at 24 September 2022, the goodwill has an in-situ value of £200,000.00 and an ex-situ of between nil - £30,000.00.

#### **Leasehold Premises**

The Company's management accounts record that, as at 30 June 2022, the leasehold premises were attributed a book value of £15,187,548.02.

The Administrators understand that the Company had the benefit of a 999-year lease for the land surrounding the stadium. However, in August 2022, that lease was surrendered, and the Company subsequently entered into a new 999-year lease for part of the same land, which contained a number of restrictions.

As a result of the above, the estimated to realise value for the leasehold premises is "uncertain".

#### Plant, Machinery, Fittings and Equipment

The Company's management accounts record that, as at 30 June 2022, plant, machinery, fittings and equipment had a book value of £693,238.88. Eddisons have subsequently valued these assets at £123,400.00 (on an in-situ basis) and £48,200.00 (on an ex-situ basis).

It is anticipated that these assets will comprise part of the sale to the proposed purchaser, although the parties have not yet agreed how the consideration for the sale shall be allocated across the various categories of assets. Therefore, the ex-situ valuation of £48,200.00 has been used for the estimated to realise amount.

#### **IT Equipment**

The Company's management accounts record that, as at 30 June 2022, IT equipment had a book value of £720,808.23. Eddisons have subsequently valued the Company's IT equipment at £13,700.00 (on an in-situ basis) and £4,400.00 (on an ex-situ basis).

It is anticipated that these assets will comprise part of the sale to the proposed purchaser although the parties have not yet agreed how the consideration for the sale shall be allocated across the various categories of assets. Therefore, the ex-situ valuation of £4,400.00 has been used for the estimated to realise amount.

#### Stock |

The Company's management accounts record that, as at 30 June 2022, stock had a book value of £77,396.05. Eddisons have valued the Company's stock at £5,100.00 (on an in-situ basis) and £1,300.00 (on an ex-situ basis).

It is anticipated that these assets will comprise part of the sale to the proposed purchaser although the parties have not yet agreed how the consideration for the sale shall be allocated across the various categories of assets. Therefore, the ex-situ valuation of £1,300.00 has been used for the estimated to realise amount.

#### **Book Debts**

The Company's management accounts record that, as at 30 June 2022, the Company had outstanding trade debtors in the aggregate amount of £455,932.00.

Whilst there are no known issues as regards collection of these debts, a general bad debt provision of 20% has been applied, indicating an estimated to realise value of £364,745.60.

#### Other Debtors

The Company's management accounts record that, as at 30 June 2022, the Company had other debtors in the aggregate amount of £612,329.36, which comprised amounts owing to the Company by connected entities.

We are informed by the Directors that the connected entities are creditors of the Company. The Administrators will investigate this matter in carrying out our statutory duties, but for the purposes of the Statement of Affairs the estimated to realise value is "uncertain".

#### Cash at Bank

The Company's management accounts recorded that, as at 30 June 2022, the Company had cash at bank of £80,294.10. The amounts held in the Company's bank accounts as at the date of our appointment was £135,756.05.

#### Petty Cash

The Company's management accounts record that, as at 30 June 2022, the Company had petty cash of £580.00. However, the balance held as at the date of our appointment totalled £9,610.00.

#### **PRIMARY PREFERENTIAL CREDITORS**

There are no known primary preferential creditors.

#### SECONDARY PREFERENTIAL CREDITORS

HMRC are estimated to be owed £2,187,493.27 in respect of unpaid VAT.

#### **NON-PREFERENTIAL UNSECURED CREDITORS**

The Company's non-preferential unsecured creditors are estimated to total £5,830,969.47 and comprise the following:

#### 6. THE ADMINISTRATION PERIOD

#### **RECEIPTS AND PAYMENTS**

Attached at Appendix 1 is our account of receipts and payments from the commencement of the administration on 27 September 2022 until 18 November 2022.

#### **Trading Receipts and Payments**

As detailed below, we were required to incur certain overheads irrespective of whether we traded the non rugby event side of the business. For example, it was necessary to incur costs in connection with instructing certain staff members (on a contractor basis) to secure the stadium, maintaining IT hosting costs and providing us with the necessary information on the Company's affairs. To date trading losses total £25k but this includes a proportion of the overheads we were going to incur irrespective of whether we were trading the business.

#### **Non-Trading Receipts and Payments**

#### Receipts

The majority of the Company's assets (goodwill, IT equipment and plant and machinery) will be realised on completion of the sale of business and assets to the consortium fronted by Jim O'Toole. Therefore, those assets have not yet been realised. I confirm that the consortium has paid a non-refundable deposit of £500k subject to our ability to complete the transaction.

#### **Payments**

The only material payment to date relates to the costs of restoring and keeping live the Company's IT infrastructure which was provided by EBC Group.

#### Work undertaken by the Administrators and their staff

In the time since the date of our appointment the following work has been completed:

#### General case administration and planning

Since our appointment we have prepared a case planning and strategy memorandum, carried out regular reviews of the case and held frequent strategy meetings with our instructed solicitors, engaged with various stakeholders including the PRL, RFU, DCMS and other creditors, engaged with a prospective purchaser of the women's rugby club and negotiated sale terms, dealt with routine correspondence and emails, maintained physical and electronic records, maintained the Administrators' bank account and filed relevant correspondence. We have also carried out reviews of the Administrators' insurance bond and of our ethics and anti-money laundering procedure.

The majority of the above work derived no financial benefit for creditors. However, the Insolvency Profession is a highly regulated industry, and we are required to maintain records to demonstrate how the case was administered and to document the reasons for any decisions that materially affect the case.

#### Compliance with the Insolvency Act, Rules and best practice

We are required to ensure that the necessary notifications of our appointment as Joint Administrators are provided to the Company, the Company's creditors and various other stakeholders. Time has also been spent notifying all relevant parties (in accordance with statute) of our appointment, which has included filing notice of our appointment with Companies House and advertising this in the London Gazette, liaising with the Directors in respect of the preparation of the Company's Statement of Affairs, preparing our Proposals and issuing these to creditors, sending a VAT 769 Notification to HMRC and liaising with creditors in respect of our appointment.

The majority of the above work derived no financial benefit for creditors. However, the Insolvency Profession is a highly regulated industry, and we are required to ensure that we comply with statute and best practice guidelines.

#### **Investigations**

Creditors should note that significant work has been carried out by the Administrators since their appointment. Whilst the Administrators are required to conduct an initial assessment of the affairs of the Company, it is also envisaged that this may result in the realisation of additional assets for the benefit of creditors.

To not prejudice their position as regards any potential claims that may be brought, the Administrators do not propose to disclose any detailed information at this stage. Full details will be provided to creditors as and when we consider it appropriate to do so.

However, general work carried out by the Administrators and in respect of our investigations is as follows:

- Writing to creditors and requesting that they provide us with details of their claims against the Company and with any information that may assist us with our investigations into the Company's affairs and the conduct of its Directors.
- Writing to the Company's Directors to seek clarification on the nature of transactions between the Company and various connected parties, requesting that they complete a detailed questionnaire pertaining to their time in office and reviewing those responses.
- Liaising with the former employees of WRFC Players Limited ("Players") as regards the nature of transactions between the Company and various connected parties.
- Writing to and liaising with the Company's instructed solicitors, requesting copies of their files and reviewing the nature of their instruction.
- Writing to and liaising with the Company's instructed accountant and auditors, requesting copies of their files and reviewing the information contained within those files.
- Conducting Land Registry searches on assets formerly owned by the Company to understand the nature of their disposals.
- Writing to the Company's bank and requesting copy bank statements for the 6 year period prior to our appointment and analysing those statements as regards payments and receipts to and from various parties in the lead up to insolvency.
- Reviewing and comparing the Company's management accounts to its filed accounts, establishing any movements in the Company's assets year on year.
- Securing a copy of the Company's server and reviewing the information held on it.
- Reviewing property/land transactions entered into prior to our appointment.

We have a statutory duty to carry out these investigations and to report to the Insolvency Service on the Directors' conduct. Furthermore, this work may result in additional asset realisations which could enable us to distribute funds to the Company's secured and unsecured creditors.

#### Realisation of assets

The following work has been carried out in respect of the Company's assets:

• Sale of the Company's Business and Assets: Following our appointment, we commenced marketing the Company's business and assets in order to identify prospective purchasers.

This work included approaching parties who had previously been in discussions with the Company's Directors, as well as approaching individuals within the industry and local business owners who may have an interest in acquiring the business and/or assets.

A data room was set up which included detailed information as regards the Company's assets, trading history, finances and liabilities. The Administrators received interest from a total of 19 parties, 12 of which returned signed non-disclosure agreements to access the data room.

Following receipt of the signed non-disclosure agreements, the Administrators engaged in detailed discussions with a number of interested parties and received three offers for the business and assets.

As detailed above, on 5 October 2022 the Administrators were also appointed as Receivers over both the Sixways Stadium and the entire issued share capital of MQ Property (owned by Worcester Sports Limited). As a result of these appointments, we are in a position to sell the Club's business and related assets as a going concern in order to achieve the highest possible returns to creditors.

The offer from the consortium fronted by Jim O'Toole represented the best return to creditors as the global offer was significantly higher than the other parties' offers. This was supported by the valuations undertaken by Eddisons. As such, the Administrators accepted the offer subject to contract on 25 October 2022 and entered into an exclusivity agreement on 29 October 2022. The Administrators have received and are holding the exclusivity fee of £500,000.

Each of the offers were considered in conjunction with the valuation information provided by Eddisons. Other details concerning the offers were discussed with Bryan Cave Leighton Paisner LLP, who are our legal advisors.

During the period of exclusivity, which expires on 17:00 on 30 November 2022 (or such longer period as the parties may agree), it will be for the consortium to satisfy the RFU's 'Change of Control' requirements and to agree terms with DCMS in relation to the transfer of their secured debt to the purchasing entity ("NewCo").

The consortium led by Jim O'Toole has also since paid in full amounts owing by MQ Property to Triangle Estate & Petroleum Limited of approximately £634k.

Please note that Eddisons are a subsidiary of Begbies Traynor Group. Eddisons are professional agents with significant experience in valuing insolvent business and assets. Furthermore, Eddisons have a specialist property division and complete property options and valuations. They have had previous involvement in valuating stadiums and other insolvent sport club assets.

Sale of Women's Rugby: The Administrators were approached by a party unconnected to Jim
O'Toole who was interested in purchasing the Company's women's rugby team, so as to enable it to
continue to compete in the current season. If a sale of the women's club was not affected, then the
women's team would have been unable to participate in the Allianz Premier 15s league.

We have been working with the third party, the consortium fronted by Jim O'Toole, DCMS and the RFU to agree a sale of the women's team and associated assets, and in doing so have ensured that such sale will not impact upon the wider sale of the Company's business and assets.

The legal documents to give effect to the sale of assets have been materially agreed and we understand that the proposed purchaser has obtained the necessary approvals from the RFU.

P Shares and Fixed Interest Stocks: Following our appointment as Administrators of the Company, we made contact with PRL to ascertain the position with respect to the Company's shares in the PRL (which are subject to a shareholders' agreement between the PRL and the other Premiership clubs). The terms of the shareholders' agreement remain confidential, although it does contain a call option which enables certain parties to acquire the Company's shares in certain circumstances, including in the event of the Company entering administration).

We are continuing to liaise with PRL to establish whether the share option will be exercised by the relevant parties.

- Leasehold Property: We have carried out Land Registry searches and obtained and reviewed copies of the Company's current and former leases from the Company's former solicitors. This matter is ongoing and forms part of our investigations into the Company's affairs.
- Book Debts: As detailed above, as at the date of our appointment the Company had total debtors of £455,932.00. Following our appointment, we employed a number of staff on a contract basis to assist with the Club's day-to-day operations, including with debt collection matters.
- We have been advised that in August 2022, to avoid the risk of debtor monies being paid into the Company's bank account (which had been frozen due to the issuance of HMRC's winding up petition against the Company), the Directors requested that debtors to the value of £36,862.25 be paid into a connected company's bank account. This matter is ongoing and forms part of our investigations into the Company's affairs.
- Other Debtors: The Company's records indicate that a connected company owes the Company £612,329.36. However, the Directors state that the relevant entity is also a creditor of the Company for a greater amount. This matter is ongoing and forms part of our investigations into the Company's affairs
- PRL Payment: The Company was entitled to receive payment of monthly distributions from PRL.
   The Company has not received payments from PRL for August and September 2022.

We have written to PRL as regards the outstanding payments and been advised that they have sought to "set off" the amounts owing by the Company to PRL from the amounts PRL owes to the Company. We are reviewing this position to determine whether any funds can be realised for the benefit of creditors.

- Cash at Bank: Following our appointment we wrote to the Company's bank and requested that it
  remit the cash at bank balance to the Administration bank account. Funds totalling £135,756.05 was
  subsequently received.
- Petty Cash: Following our appointment we secured and reconciled the Company's petty cash and paid these funds into the Administration bank account.
- Business Interruption Insurance: The Directors advised the Administrators that they had previously
  been pursuing a business interruption insurance claim against the Company's insurers. We have
  liaised with the Company's insurance brokers to establish the basis of the claim and the reasons for
  the insurer's initial rejection of it.
- Trading: We were required to incur certain overheads irrespective of whether we traded the non rugby event side of the business. For example, it was necessary to incur costs in connection with

instructing certain staff members (on a contractor basis) to secure the stadium, maintaining IT hosting costs and providing us with the necessary information on the Company's affairs. Therefore, we analysed the financial impact of various events to determine whether they generated sufficent profit to contribute to the overheads. The following key events have been held together with other smaller events:

- i. Fireworks This has historically been one of the Company's largest event outside of its rugby operations. We assessed the viability of running the event in Administration with the Sixways Events team and concluded that it would be both profitable and beneficial to the local Worcester community. The event achieved almost 4,000 attendees and is expected to generate a profit of c.£10,000 towards overheads.
- ii. Modus Cup Another larger event run at the Sixways Stadium is the Modus Challenge Cup, which has taken place between The Royal Grammar School Worcester and King's School Worcester every year since 2007. The event also had a successful turnout and is expected to be profitable for the Club.

The receipts and payments associated with the above events are still being reconciled; however, both were profitable and have contributed to the ongoing holding costs at the Sixways Stadium.

- Prepayments: As above, we are currently reviewing whether there is any realisable value in respect
  of prepayments.
- Relegation Appeal: On 26 September 2022, the RFU wrote to the Club and suspended it from all
  competitions in accordance with Regulation 6.4 of the RFU Regulations.

On 28 September 2022, we sent formal notification of an Insolvency Event pursuant to Regulation 5.5.1 of the RFU Regulations. Our letter also requested that the RFU disapplies the automatic relegation provision contain in Regulation 5.5.5.

On 10 November 2022, we submitted an appeal to the RFU detailing the reasons why the Company's entry into administration should be characterised as a "no-fault insolvency", meaning that the automatic relegation should be disapplied. We are waiting for the outcome of such appeal and will keep the Supporters Group updated in this respect.

We have held meetings with the RFU/PRL and have intended Investor Group meetings

#### Dealing with creditors' claims (including employees), correspondence and distributions

Since our appointment we have dealt with creditor correspondence, emails and telephone conversations, maintained up to date creditor records and amended claims received, and discussed the progress of the administration with creditors.

We have also liaised with creditors who have assets on site and facilitated the return of those items where it was considered appropriate to do so. Best practice means that we should respond to creditors in a timely manner.

Case specific matters include the following:

• Rugby creditors: In accordance with the RFU's Change of Control requirements, any purchaser of the Club must satisfy all creditors which are characterised by the RFU as "rugby creditors" within 28 days of being issued a license to play in the appropriate league.

We have liaised with the Company's former employees and the Redundancy Payments Service ("RPS") regarding the quantification of employee claims so that this can be included in the rugby creditor list.

We have also had a number of discussions with the RFU in relation to the definition of rugby creditors to ensure that the rugby creditors list is as accurate as possible.

• Supporters club: We met with representatives of the supporters club given the interest in the administration and held a question-and-answer session with them. The question-and-answers were subsequently posted on relevant social media channels.

Other matters which includes seeking decisions of creditors via deemed consent procedure and/or decision procedures, tax, litigation, pensions and travel

We have undertaken relevant searches to establish the presence of any occupational pension schemes. These searches have confirmed that the Company did not operate a occupational pension scheme.

The majority of the above work derived no financial benefit for creditors. However, the Insolvency Profession is a highly regulated industry, and we are required to ensure that the above work is completed in line with statute and best practice guidelines.

#### ESTIMATED OUTCOME FOR CREDITORS

The sums owed to creditors at the date of appointment (as detailed in the directors' statement of affairs) are as follows:

#### Secured creditor

The English Sports Council (as programme manager) was granted a fixed charge on 17 February 2021 over the Company's P Shares in PRL and its invested units in Premier Rugby Limited. The charge was registered on the same day.

The English Sports Council (as programme manager) was granted a floating charge on 17 February 2021 over the Company's remaining assets. The charge was registered on the same day.

The amount owing to English Sports Council (as programme manager) / DCMS as at the date of our appointment was £16,134,720.40, comprising principal debt of £15,706,000.00 and interest of £428,720.40, but excluding enforcement and other costs recoverable by DCMS under its fixed and floating charge.

#### Preferential creditors

There are no known preferential creditors as the club's employees were employed by WRFC Players Ltd, a subsidiary of the Company. WRFC Players Ltd entered into compulsory liquidation on 5 October 2022 as a result of a winding up petition issued by HMRC in respect of unpaid debts totalling £6,858,439.59.

#### Secondary preferential creditors

Further to the changes to the Finance Act 2020, HMRC are now able to claim secondary preferential status for certain liabilities. Taxes owed by the business to HMRC comprising of VAT, PAYE Income Tax, Employee National Insurance Contributions, Student loan deductions and Construction Industry Scheme deductions fall under the secondary preferential status.

The secondary preferential claim of HMRC is estimated at £2,187,493.27 in relation to HMRC's claim for VAT only as the Company was not PAYE registered.

#### **Unsecured creditors**

The Company's non-preferential unsecured creditors are estimated to total £5,830,969.47 and comprise the following:

On the basis of realisations to date and estimated future realisations we estimate an outcome for each class of the Company's creditor as follows:

#### Secured creditor

It is presently difficult to accurately estimate the outcome for DCMS, as it largely depends on whether the call option in respect of the P Share is exercised. However, any residual liabilities to DCMS will be transferred to the Newco on completion of the sale of business and assets (subject to commercial terms being agreed).

#### **Preferential creditors**

There are no known preferential creditors.

#### Secondary preferential creditors

We consider that there are likely to be sufficient funds for a dividend to be paid to HMRC. However, we are not in a position to estimate the timing and quantum of any distribution at this stage.

#### Prescribed Part for unsecured creditors pursuant to Section 176A of the Act

Section 176A of the Act provides that, where the company has created a floating charge on or after 15 September 2003, the administrator must make a *prescribed part* of the Company's *net property* available for the unsecured creditors and not distribute it to the floating charge holder except in so far as it exceeds the amount required for the satisfaction of unsecured debts. *Net property* means the amount which would, were it not for this provision, be available to floating charge holders out of floating charge assets (i.e. after accounting for preferential debts and the costs of realising the floating charge assets). The floating charge holder may not participate in the distribution of the prescribed part of the Company's net property is calculated by reference to a sliding scale as follows:

_	50% of the first £10,000 of net property;
<b>-</b>	20% of net property thereafter;
_	Up to a maximum amount to be made available of £800,000

An administrator will not be required to set aside the prescribed part of net property if:

- the *net property* is less than £10,000 <u>and</u> the administrator thinks that the cost of distributing the *prescribed part* would be disproportionate to the benefit; (Section 176A(3)) or
- the administrator applies to the court for an order on the grounds that the cost of distributing the prescribed part would be disproportionate to the benefit and the court orders that the provision shall not apply (Section 176A(5)).

We have estimated, to the best of our knowledge and belief, the Company's net property after costs, is nil and there will be no distribution to unsecured creditors via the prescribed part. This is in part due to the quantum of HMRC's Secondary preferential claim.

#### **Unsecured creditors**

Based upon realisations to date and estimated future realisations there will be insufficient funds available to enable a dividend to be paid to the unsecured creditors.

#### Effect of administration on limitation periods under the Limitation Act 1980

As explained in our initial correspondence confirming our appointment as administrators, the Limitation Act 1980 continues to apply to all debts due from the Company. Case law indicates that where a company is in administration, time does not stop running for limitation purposes pursuant to the Limitation Act 1980. If you have any concerns in relation to your claim against the Company becoming time-barred during the course of the administration, we strongly recommend that you seek independent legal advice on the options available to you to prevent this.

# 8. OUR PROPOSALS FOR ACHIEVING THE PURPOSE OF THE ADMINISTRATION

#### **Purpose of the Administration**

We are required to set out our proposals for achieving the purpose of the administration which in this context means one of the objectives specified in paragraph 3 of Schedule B1 to the Act as set out at section 3 of this report above.

For the reasons set out in this report, we presently consider that it is not reasonably practicable to achieve either of the objectives specified in sub-paragraph 3(1)(a) and 3(1)(b), and consequently the most appropriate objective to pursue in this case is that specified in sub-paragraph 3(1)(c), namely realising property in order to make a distribution to one or more secured or preferential creditors. Furthermore, we consider that pursuing this objective should not unnecessarily harm the interests of the creditors of the Company as a whole.

We are not able to rescue the Company as a going concern as detailed in sub-paragraph 3(1)(a) as we did not receive any offers for the Company's share capital. This is due to the quantum of creditors including HMRC's debt

The objective of sub-paragraph 3(1)(b) is states that the administration achieves a better result for the company's creditors as a whole than would be likely if the company were wound up (without first being in Administration). We are unable to satisfy this objective as we anticipate that there will be insufficient asset realisations to enable a distribution to unsecured creditors.

As a result, sub-paragraph 3(1)(c), namely realising property in order to make a distribution to one or more secured or preferential creditors is being pursued. In order that the purpose of the administration may be fully achieved, we propose to remain in office as administrators in order to conclude the following matters:

- The sale of business and assets to the consortium fronted by Jim O'Toole.
- Realising the Company's other assets such as the trade debtors.
- Our investigations into the Company's affairs.

Following these events, we propose to finalise distributions to the secured and preferential creditors.

#### **Exit from Administration**

On present information we consider that the Company will have insufficient property to enable a distribution to be made to unsecured creditors. Consequently, as soon as we are satisfied that we have fully discharged our duties as Administrators and that the purpose of the Administration has been fully achieved, we propose to deliver a notice of moving from Administration to dissolution to the Registrar of Companies. Upon the

registration of such notice our appointment as Administrators ceases to have effect, and at the end of three months the Company will automatically be dissolved.

Where an Administrator sends such a notice of dissolution to the Registrar of Companies, he must also file a copy of the notice with the court and send a copy to each creditor of the Company, and on application by any interested party the court may suspend or disapply the automatic dissolution of the Company.

However, it may transpire that it is not possible to finalise the Administration as envisaged within one year of the date of our appointment. In particular, this situation will arise if we are not able to conclude our investigations into the Company's affairs. The appointment of an Administrator shall cease to have effect at the end of the period of one year beginning with the date on which it takes effect. However, our term of office may be extended either by court order for a specified period or by consent of the creditors for a specified period not exceeding twelve months. It may therefore become necessary at some future time for us to seek creditor consent to extending the period of the administration for up to a further twelve months following the anniversary of our appointment in order to ensure that the objective of the administration can be fully achieved.

#### PRE-ADMINISTRATION COSTS

At this stage we are not seeking approval of the pre-appointment Administration costs.

#### 10. REMUNERATION AND EXPENSES

#### Remuneration

We have not at this time drawn any funds on account of our remuneration, nor on account of certain expenses as approval has not previously been sought.

At this stage, we are not seeking fee approval from the relevant class of creditors as it is difficult to accurately estimate our likely time costs due to the complexity of the matter and the significant investigations required to determine the purpose and outcome of various transactions including the use of CVC funds and land/property transactions.

However, we have included details of our time costs incurred to date at Appendix 3 for reasons of transparency.

#### **Estimate of expenses**

We are required by the Rules to provide creditors with details of the expenses that we consider will be, or are likely to be, incurred in the course of the Administration. This information also appears at Appendix 4.

#### Expenditure incurred to date

As detailed above, Bryan Cave Leighton Paisner LLP have been instructed as our legal advisors. They charge on a time costs basis and their time costs to date are £269,498.50. These costs relate to the work undertaken on the sale of the Company's business and assets, advising on specific insolvency points and their work in relation to the investigations into the Company's affairs including property transactions.

#### 11. OTHER INFORMATION TO ASSIST CREDITORS

#### Report on the conduct of directors

We have a statutory duty to investigate the conduct of the directors and any person we consider to be or have been a shadow or de facto director during the period of three years before the date of our appointment, in relation to their management of the affairs of the Company and the causes of its failure. We are obliged to submit confidential reports to the Department for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy.

As Administrators of the Company, we are required by best practice guidance to make enquiries of creditors as to whether they wish to raise any concerns regarding the way in which the Company's business was

conducted prior to the commencement of the administration or wish to bring to our attention any potential recoveries for the estate. If you would like to bring any such issues to our attention, please do so in writing to the address detailed at Section 1 of this report. This request for information is standard practice and does not imply any criticism or cause of action against any person concerned in the management of the Company's affairs.

#### Investigations carried out to date

We have undertaken an initial assessment of possible actions in relation to the manner in which the business was conducted prior to the administration of the Company and potential recoveries for the estate in this respect. Our investigations focus on the following matters:

- i. Intercompany debtor and creditor positions.
- ii. Wrongful trading.
- iii. Land and property transfers entered into by the Company prior to Administration.
- iv. Reviewing the Company's bank statements to determine the use of funds and whether the Company entered into any preference payments or transactions at undervalue.

Note that we are not stating that there are any valid claims at this stage. However, we have a statutory duty to investigate the Company's affairs to determine whether there are any claims against the directors or any other party.

#### Connected party transactions

The Joint Administrators have not sold any Company assets to connected parties.

#### **Deemed delivery**

These proposals will be deemed to have been delivered on 22 November 2022.

#### Use of personal information

Please note that in the course of discharging our statutory duties as Joint Administrators, we may need to access and use personal data, being information from which a living person can be identified. Where this is necessary, we are required to comply with data protection legislation. If you are an individual and you would like further information about your rights in relation to our use of your personal data, you can access the same at <a href="https://www.begbies-traynorgroup.com/privacy-notice">https://www.begbies-traynorgroup.com/privacy-notice</a>. If you require a hard copy of the information, please do not hesitate to contact us.

#### Right to request further information

Pursuant to Rule 18.9 of the Rules, within 21 days of the receipt of this report a secured creditor, or an unsecured creditor with the concurrence of at least 5% in value of the unsecured creditors, including that creditor, (or an unsecured creditor with less than 5% in value of the unsecured creditors, but with the permission of the court) may request in writing that we provide further information about our remuneration or expenses which have been incurred during the period of this progress report.

#### Right to make an application to court

Pursuant to Rule 18.34 of the Rules, any secured creditor or any unsecured creditor with the concurrence of at least 10% in value of the unsecured creditors including that creditor, (or any unsecured creditors with less than 10% in value of the unsecured creditors, but with the permission of the court) may, within 8 weeks of receipt of this progress report, make an application to court on the grounds that the remuneration charged or the expenses incurred during the period of this progress report are excessive or, the basis fixed for our remuneration is inappropriate.

#### 12. CONCLUSION

In the circumstances, we are not required to seek a decision from the creditors on the approval of our proposals. However, creditors, whose debts amount to at least 10% of the total debts of the Company, may request that a decision is sought from the unsecured creditors as to whether to approve our proposals, via a qualifying decision procedure. Any such request must be delivered to our office in writing within 8 business days of 22 November 2022. If no such requests are received, our proposals are deemed to have been approved by the creditors. Where the proposals are deemed to have been approved, we will write to you to confirm that is the position.

Subject to the approval of our proposals we will report on progress again approximately six months after the commencement of the administration.
