NOTES TO THE ABBREVIATED ACCOUNTS

YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2014

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of accounting

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention, and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

Going concern

Further to the directors actions the company has returned a profit in the year. In the directors' opinions these actions will be sufficient to maintain the company as a going concern and these financial statements have been prepared on that basis. The directors confirm that they have considered a period of at least 12 months from the date of signing these financial statements.

Turnover

The turnover shown in the profit and loss account represents amounts invoiced during the year and bankings received, exclusive of Value Added Tax, from all sources.

In respect of membership subscriptions and deposits made on account at the balance sheet date which refer to future periods then the relevant proportion of such income is deferred and included in creditors in these financial statements.

Fixed assets

All fixed assets are initially recorded at cost.

Depreciation

Depreciation is calculated so as to write off the cost of an asset, less its estimated residual value, over the useful economic life of that asset as follows:

Plant & Machinery

over 4 to 10 years

Stocks

Stocks are valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value, after making due allowance for obsolete and slow moving items.

Hire purchase agreements

Assets held under hire purchase agreements are capitalised and disclosed under tangible fixed assets at their fair value. The capital element of the future payments is treated as a liability and the interest is charged to the profit and loss account on a straight line basis.

Operating lease agreements

Rentals applicable to operating leases where substantially all of the benefits and risks of ownership remain with the lessor are charged against profits on a straight line basis over the period of the lease.
