Minutes of the Extraordinary General Meeting of Clandon Regis Golf Club Limited Held on 6th October 2007

Ian Mitchell, Club President, opened up proceedings by welcoming all the Members present to the EGM of Clandon Regis Golf Club Ltd He said apologies had been received from 38 Members, which had been recorded Ian then said that the EGM would be immediately followed by the 2007 AGM of the Company He then introduced Mike Savage, Company Chairman, to continue the meeting

Mike thanked Ian and wished all Members present a good morning He said that the only item of business to be considered at the EGM was a proposal to alter the Articles of Association to grant voting rights to Intermediate Members

Mike said that, as he had mentioned in previous newsletters, an Intermediate Member of the Club may attend an AGM at CRGC Ltd, but may not vote on any matter put before them He explained to members of the meeting that Intermediate Members are Members of the Club aged between 18 and 26 At the moment, we have 41 Intermediate Members and they are an important group within the Club They are mostly very active golfers and include a number of our better golfers. It is to the Intermediate category that our 67 Juniors will progress when they are 18 years of age

Mike said that although Intermediate Members do not generally take an active part in the administration of the Club or of the golf Sections as many of them have other distractions, making their way through professional studies or into a career But this does not mean they should not have the same opportunity as you or me to express their view in the way the Club goes about its business or be able to vote on matters affecting their golf club

Mike said that the Special Resolution that is before the Meeting and which is unanimously supported by the Board is that Article 22 1 of the Articles of Association be amended to

"Every Member may attend General Meetings but only Full Members and Intermediate Members may vote at such Meetings Country, Overseas, Junior, Social, Honorary and Temporary Members may not vote, unless they are also Founder Debenture holders"

This proposed amendment does not affect or alter the rights of any Member in any other category of Membership

Mike asked whether anyone had any comment to make about this matter before he put it to a vote?

There were no comments so Mike asked all those in favour to raise their hands

The vote was carried unanimously with no Members present against the proposal

Mike thanked the Members for their support and declared the Special Resolution carried

He said that concluded the business for the E G M and that we would now proceed to the business of the Annual General Meeting
