1 Accounting policies

Accounting ConventionThe financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008). Compliance with accounting standards The financial statements are prepared in accordance with applicable United Kingdom Accounting Standards (United Kingdom Generally Accepted Accounting Practice), which have been applied consistently (except as otherwise stated). Leasing and hire purchase commitments Assets obtained under hire purchase contracts and finance leases are capitalised as tangible assets and depreciated over the shorter of the lease term and their useful lives. Obligations under such agreements are included in creditors net of the finance charge allocated to future periods. The finance element of the rental payment is charged to the profit and loss account so as to produce a constant periodic rate of charge on the net obligation outstanding in each period. Rentals payable under operating leases are charged against income on a straight line basis over the lease term. Stock and work in progress Stock is valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value. Work in progress is calculated on the basis of costs incurred on specific contracts. If the ultimate profitability of the contract can be assessed with reasonable certainty, having made a prudent allowance for future costs, then profit is recognised in proportion to the contract work completed. Immediate provision is made for foreseeable losses. Deferred taxation Deferred taxation is provided in full in respect of taxation deferred by timing differences between the treatment of certain items for taxation and accounting purposes. The deferred tax balance has not been discounted.

Turnover

Turnover represents amounts receivable for goods and services net of VAT and trade discounts.
