Background to Administration Order

- Titan Holdings Limited was incorporated on 2 December 1996. The principle place of 1.1 business was Boothtown, Halifax although the company also operated a satellite sales office in Bedford.
- The principal activity of the company was that of the design, manufacture and supply of 1.2 hydraulic equipment and services.
- The company traded successfully for a number of years, winning a number of high profile 1.3 contracts. However, due to various quality and delivery issues, losses were suffered on some contracts.
- A programme of rationalisation during 2007 (including the closure of the plant at Leeds) was 1.4 expected to result in significant cost savings both in terms of overheads and employment costs.
- Slow paying customers, significantly exceeding payment terms, resulted in cash flow 1.5 difficulties and pressure from suppliers.
- By April 2008 the company had arrears of PAYE and NIC amounting to £287,661 and HM 1.6 Revenue & Customs distrained over various items of plant and machinery.
- The company entered a walking possession agreement and in May 2008 entered into a 1.7 payment arrangement to make payments of £10,000 per week to HM Revenue & Customs, against which some £210,000 was paid.
- The company had entered into a confidential discounting agreement with Skipton Business 1.8 Finance Limited ("Skipton") in July 2004. This was later converted into a factoring agreement.
- Concerns by Skipton resulted in the introduction of PKF (UK) LLP to the directors in 1.9 September 2008. At this time there was insufficient financial information upon which to base formal advice. Advice was given as to the form of financial forecasts upon which decisions as to future trading might be based.
- A number of subsequent meetings were held to review the forecasts and to advise the 1.10 directors on their responsibilities to creditors.
- At the end of November 2008, the directors formed the opinion that they could not secure the 1.11 necessary working capital to enable the company to continue trading and steps were taken to place the company into Administration.

Appointment and Strategy

- The assets of the company were valued by Philip Davies & Sons Auctioneers & Valuers prior 2.1 to our appointment. Based on the valuation advice received, a sale of the free assets to Titan Manufacturing Limited ("TML"), a new company established by the directors, was completed on 11 December 2008.
- HM Revenue and Customs refused to withdraw the walking possession agreement made in 2.2 May 2008 but agreed to allow TML to continue to use the assets in question for ongoing trading.
- These assets were excluded from the sale agreement entered into by the Administrators and 2.3
- TML are actively seeking to arrange asset finance over such items of plant and machinery 2.4 and will need to remit the sums raised to HM Revenue & Customs. Should the funds raised not meet the HM Revenue & Customs' valuation, TML will need to meet the excess from future profits. Whilst TML initially agreed to deal with this issue during the first two weeks of January 2009, we understand that finance has yet to be finalised.
- A sale to TML was considered the best possible realisation in all the prevailing 2.5 circumstances. The offer made by TML was in excess of the restricted realisation price detailed in our agent's report. In addition, the offer included transferring all employees to the new company, therefore avoiding any employee claims in the Administration.
- The offer accepted was less than the "going concern" valuation but the going concern 2.6 valuation would have been impossible to generate in the circumstnces. Titan traded from leasehold premises owned by a company linked by common ownership. The nature of the lease was such that no outside purchaser would ever have been in a position to purchase the assets in situ. The costs of regularising the lease would have eliminated any worth in the building contents. Further, the costs of uplifting machinery such as this for re-location in an alternative building would have been prohibitive.
- The offer accepted represented the best net return to the estate. 2.7

Financial Position of the Company 3

- The directors were advised of their duty to provide a statement of affairs of the Company as 3.1 at the date of our appointment, pursuant to paragraph 47(1) of Schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986.
- To date the statement of affairs has not been received. However the information gathered 3.2 from our time working on site and contained in our agents' report is deemed to be sufficient for the purposes of this report. A schedule of the Company's creditors is attached at appendix II pursuant to Rule 2.33(2)(j) of the Insolvency Rules 1986.

Asset Realisations

Total consideration for the sale of the free assets was agreed at £65,000 and has been 3.3 apportioned as follows:-

> £10,000 Plant: Stock: £30,000 WIP: £25,000

Forecasts prepared by TML indicated that whilst a return to profitability could be achieved, 3.4 they had insufficient working capital and were unable to raise funds at the outset to purchase the assets outright. It was therefore agreed the £65,000 would be paid in instalments as follows:-

> 15 December 2008 £10,000 22 December 2008 £5,000 £5,000 5 January 2009 And £5,000 a week thereafter for 9 weeks

The first instalment of £10,000 has been received by Halliwells LLP and the first four 3.5 instalments of £5,000 (to 19 January 2009) have been paid into the Administration bank account. The remaining £5,000 payments should be paid into the Administration account by direct debit on the specified dates.

Liabilities

Secured Creditors

- There are no assets subject to fixed charge security. 3.6
- The book debts factored with Skipton Business Finance Limited are formally assigned to 3.7 Skipton and are therefore the company no longer has title to them.



- There are items of plant and machinery which are subject to higher purchase agreements. 3.8 However our agents have advised there is little or no equity in these assets. These assets have consequently been left for the new company to either adopt the agreements or to arrange to have the assets collected.
- The unencumbered assets of the company are subject to floating charge debentures with 3.9 Skipton Business Finance Limited dated 1 July 2004 and the Royal Bank of Scotland plc ("RBS") dated 31 March 2005.
- If the sales consideration is received in full, there maybe a small distribution under Skipton's 3.10 floating charge, after allowing for the prescribed part.
- The company operated banking facilities with the Royal Bank of Scotland plc. As at the date 3.11 of appointment of Administrators, the amount due to RBS in respect of the over drawn bank account was £39,780. RBS hold a debenture over the company, together with an unlimited guarantee pledged by Place Trace Limited.

Preferential Creditors

All employees were transferred to TML. As a result there are no preferential creditors. 3.7

Non - Preferential Creditors

- From information provided by the director and correspondence received from creditors, it 3.8 appears that there are 218 creditors owed approximately £753,618 in total. However, not all creditors have notified us of their claims and as a result this figure is only provisional.
- Included in the above, the company has liabilities to H M Revenue and Customs in respect 3.9 of unpaid VAT totalling £56,594. This claim is estimated as returns are currently outstanding.

Prescribed Part

- Section 176A of the Insolvency Act 1986 requires Administrators to set aside a prescribed 3.10 amount of the company's 'net property' towards the satisfaction of non-preferential claims. 'Net property' is defined as the amount which would, if it were not for the aforementioned provision, be available to floating charge holders (created after 15 September 2003), after accounting for fixed charges, preferential creditors and the costs of realisation.
- As the floating charges were created after 15 September 2003, the Administrator must make 3.11 part of the net property available for unsecured creditors and not distribute it to the holder of a floating charge.

Dividend Prospects

If the sales consideration is received in full there will be sufficient funds available to make a 3.12 nominal distribution to the unsecured creditors under the Prescribed Part.

Receipts and Payments

- A receipts and payments account from the date of appointment to 22 January 2009 is attached at Appendix III.
- As at 22 January 2009 the Administrators are holding £22,481. Funds in hand are being 4.2 held in interest bearing accounts where appropriate.

Joint Administrators' Remuneration 5

- Enclosed as Appendix IV is a summary of the Joint Administrators' time costs from the date 5.1 of appointment until 22 January 2009, prepared in accordance with Statement of Insolvency Practice No. 9; those time costs amount to £13,660 plus VAT.
- The time costs are derived by reference to PKF (UK) LLP's normal rates for time properly 5.2 spent by the Joint Administrators and their staff in attending to matters arising in this administration. Where members of staff have been engaged on the administration they have been so based on their experience and abilities. Where appropriate, certain staff have dealt with a specific area of the administration due to their skills in that area. Our scale rates may increase from time to time over the period of the administration.
- The Joint Administrators are entitled to receive remuneration for their services as 5.3 administrators of the Company. In accordance with 2.106(2) of the Insolvency Rules 1986 ('the Rules'), the Joint Administrators' remuneration shall be fixed either:
 - as a percentage of the value of the property with which they have to deal; or a)
 - by reference to the time properly spent by the Joint Administrators and their staff in b) attending to matters arising in the administration.
- The Joint Administrators propose to receive remuneration under part (b) of paragraph 5.3 5.4 above. This remuneration claim will be subject to the agreement of creditors.
- The Joint Administrators are required to draw creditors' attention to a creditors' guide to fees, 5.5 which provides information regarding creditors' rights in relation to insolvency practitioners' fees and can be obtained by visiting our website. The relevant guide can be accessed through www.pkf.co.uk/cri, then click on the right hand link to "Creditors' guides to fees". A copy of the guide can be provided upon request by contacting this office
- Total disbursements incurred from the date of appointment to 22 January 2009 but not yet 5.6 charged are as follows:

- Category 1 disbursements are those which generally comprise external supplies of incidental 5.7 services specifically identifiable to the case.
- Category 2 disbursements are generally services supplied internally and require the approval 5.8 of creditors. Mileage which is a Category 2 disbursement is charged by PKF (UK) LLP at the rate of 47p per mile. The Joint Administrators will be seeking a specific resolution of creditors to approve the charging of these disbursements.



6 Proposed Exit Route

- In due course it will be necessary for the company to exit from the Administration. This can either be into Creditors' Voluntary Liquidation, into Compulsory Liquidation or by Dissolution. Unless stated, all references to paragraph numbers in this section are reference to paragraphs in Schedule B1 of the Insolvency Act 1986.
- At the present time we are unable to categorically state whether sufficient funds will be available to make a payment to unsecured creditors under Section 176A of the Insolvency Act 1986, the prescribed part.
- 6.3 If there are insufficient funds to enable a distribution to the unsecured creditors, it is proposed that once all outstanding matters have been concluded, the Joint Administrators will be granted their release as Joint Administrators and file the requisite forms with the Registrar of Companies to place the company into the dissolution process pursuant to Paragraph 84.
- However, if there are sufficient funds to enable a dividend to the unsecured creditors then the Joint Administrators may apply to court for an order to enable the Joint Administrators to distribute the surplus funds pursuant to Paragraph 65(3). If the court sanctions such an order and payment is made to the unsecured creditors, then the Joint Administrators will be granted their release by filing the requisite forms with the Registrar of Companies to place the company into the dissolution process pursuant to Paragraph 84.
- In the event that the application to distribute to unsecured creditors is not made to the court, then the Joint Administrators will cause the Company to be placed into Creditors' Voluntary Liquidation pursuant to Paragraph 83. The Joint Administrators would be appointed as the Joint Liquidators to enable the distribution of surplus funds to the unsecured creditors of the Company. This would be the most timely and cost efficient method as it would avoid potential duplication of work by an alternative insolvency practitioner.
- In accordance with Paragraph 83(7) and Rule 2.117(3) of the Insolvency Rules 1986, creditors may nominate different persons as the proposed Joint Liquidators. All valid nominations must be made after the receipt of these proposals and before the proposals are approved, with or without modifications.
- In the event that none of the above exit routes are deemed appropriate by the Joint Administrators, it is proposed that the Joint Administrators present a petition at court for the winding up of the Company pursuant to their powers under paragraph 21 of Schedule 1 to the Insolvency Act 1986. They will also seek their appointment as joint liquidators pursuant to section 140(1) of the Insolvency Act 1986 and will seek their release as Administrators from the court pursuant to paragraph 98(2)(c).

7 Joint Administrators' Proposals

7.1 In accordance with paragraph 49 of Schedule B1 of the Insolvency Act 1986 and Rule 2.33 of the Insolvency Rules 1986, Jonathan Newell and Kerry Bailey, the Administrators of the company, make the following proposals for achieving the purpose of the Administration. Approval of the following proposals will be considered as a single resolution at the meeting of creditors to be held on 13 February 2009.

Resolution 1

- That the Joint Administrators do all such things and generally exercise all of their powers as Joint Administrators contained in Schedule 1 to the Insolvency Act 1986 as they in their discretion consider desirable or expedient, in order to achieve the purpose of the administration and to protect and preserve the assets of the Company and to maximise the realisation of those assets or for any other purpose incidental to these proposals.
- In the event that the Joint Administrators consider it appropriate, they may extend their statutory term of the administration of twelve months for a further period of up to six months, pursuant to paragraph 76(2)(b) of Schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986, and that if a further extension is considered appropriate, the Joint Administrators may make an application to court pursuant to paragraph 76(2)(a) in this regard.
- In the event that all creditors are paid in full together with the costs and expenses of the administration, any surplus funds will be handed back to the company. The Joint Administrators will then file the necessary forms with the court and the Registrar of Companies and creditors, pursuant to paragraph 80 of Schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986, to the effect that the purpose of the administration has been achieved.
- In the event that there are insufficient funds to enable a distribution to unsecured creditors, it is proposed that once all outstanding matters are concluded, the Joint Administrators will seek a resolution from creditors for their release as Joint Administrators and file the necessary forms with the Registrar of Companies to enable the Company to be dissolved pursuant to paragraph 84 of Schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986.
- That if sufficient funds are available for distribution to the unsecured creditors (but not a payment in full) then the Administrators may apply to court for an order under paragraph 65(3) of Schedule B1 of the Insolvency Act 1986 allowing them to make a payment by way of distribution to unsecured creditors. If the court sanctions such an order, and a payment is made to the unsecured creditors, then the Administrators will then seek their release from creditors as described above and file the requisite forms with the Registrar

of companies to enable the company to be placed into dissolution, pursuant to paragraph 84 of Schedule B1 of the Insolvency Act 1986.

- That in the event that the application to court for a payment by way of distribution to unsecured creditors is not made, or if a distribution cannot be made to unsecured creditors within the term of the administration (whether exceeded or not), then the Administrators will cause the company to be placed into Creditors' Voluntary Liquidation with Jonathan Newell and Kerry Bailey of PKF (UK) LLP being appointed as Joint Liquidators, by filing the requisite forms with the Registrar of Companies pursuant to paragraph 83 of Schedule B1 of the Insolvency Act 1986.
- HMR&C holds walking possession on certain of the company's assets. This provides security from the date it was signed until the sale of the assets is completed by HMR&C or where the assets are realised by an IP holding insolvency office over the sale proceeds. Paragraph 43 Schedule B1 IA 1986 precludes proceedings, execution, distress and legal process but it does not remove security once it has been obtained.

In addition, the Joint Administrators will seek approval of the following resolutions:-

Resolution 2

That the Administrators shall be remunerated on a time costs basis by reference to PKF (UK) LLP's normal rates for time spent by them and their staff attending to matters arising in the Administration.

Resolution 3

That the Administrators be authorised to draw disbursements detailed in this report and all future category 2 disbursements.

Resolution 4

That the Administrators seek a resolution from creditors pursuant to paragraph 98 of Schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986, that the Administrators be released from all liability in respect of their acts as Administrators, 14 days after their appointment as Administrators ceases to have effect.

Resolution 5

That, if thought fit, the Administrators seek a resolution from creditors establishing a creditors committee pursuant to paragraph 57 of Schedule B1 of the Insolvency Act 1986.

It should be noted that the Administrators have a statutory obligation to investigate the 7.2 conduct of directors and to prepare a report to the Insolvency Services in accordance with the provisions of the Company Directors Disqualification Act 1986. If any creditor is aware of any matter which they consider should be brought to the attention of the Administrators, please do so in writing to PKF (UK) LLP, Sovereign House, Queen Street, Manchester M2 5HR.

Conclusion 8

- The Joint Administrators have convened an initial meeting of creditors, as opposed to formal 8.1 business being conducted by correspondence.
- It is believed that the Company has insufficient property to enable a distribution to be made 8.2 to unsecured creditors other than the possibility that there may be a requirement to set aside a prescribed part by virtue of section 176A(2)(a) of the Insolvency Act 1986. This statement is made pursuant to paragraph 52(1)(b) of Schedule B1 of the Insolvency Act 1986.
- The Joint Administrators are of the view that they should continue to manage the affairs of 8.3 the Company in order to achieve the purposes of the administration.
