



ADMINISTRATION ORDER

AND UPON the Court being satisfied that the making of an Administration Order would be likely to achieve the purpose set out in this Order

IT IS ORDERED THAT:-

1. During the period for which this Order is in force, the affairs, business and property of the Company shall be managed by the Administrators hereinafter appointed pursuant to the provisions of Section 8 of the Insolvency Act 1986 and for the following purpose:-

- (a) A more advantageous realisation of the Company's assets than would be effected on a winding-up order
2. David Moore and Guy Huntington of Begbies Traynor, Number 1 Old Hall Street, Liverpool L3 9HS be appointed to be the Joint Administrators of the Company.
 3. During the period for which this Order is in force, any acts required or authorised under any enactment to be done by the Joint Administrators may be done by or all or any one or more of the persons for the time being holding that office.
 4. The Administrators are to report to the Court on or before 26th October 2001 when the Court will consider whether the Administration is to continue.
 5. The costs of and incidental to the preparation to the Independent Report dated 25th September 2001 including the legal and accountancy costs thereof and the costs of the Petition herein be paid as expenses of the Administration.
