## REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2006

#### Structure, governance and management

Governing document

Theatre Lab Company is a company limited by guarantee and a registered charity governed by its Memorandum and Articles of Association. It was incorporated on 24 November 1997. The company number is 3473003 and the registered charity number is 1102544.

#### Objectives and activities

The company has two main objectives 1) enhancing multicultural integration of the society and ii) promotion of European theatre and in particular contemporary Greek theatre (but not exclusively). The above aims are achieved by workshops for deprived and excluded groups of the community, theatre production of Greek plays translated into English, development of new and experimental theatre projects.

#### Achievements during the current financial year

New production of a new Greek play, participation in a European Festival (Prague Fringe Festival), participation in a festival in Athens and work with the Greek community

#### Review of the year and future developments

During the year the company continued its programme of promotion of contemporary European theatre to the wider audience of London. For the first time it had a co-production with the Oval Theatre in London. There were some difficulties with members of the creative team that helped the company to explore new collaborations. The participation at the Prague Fringe Festival was the most successful activity artistically and financially. The participation at the festival in Athens opened new horizons for collaboration with the national theatre of Greece. For a second year we have done a theatre production with the Greek secondary school of London with great success.

We have continued to receive funding from the Greek government and Greek foundations. Plans for the future include the development of new experimental work and participation in festivals, further work with the community, development of our links with local groups and societies in the Acton area and applications for further community funding.

#### Financial review

Grants and donations provided the company's principal source of income. In the year, funds raised were £6,827 and resources expended were £9,911. The London production did not generate the income anticipated.

### NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2006

#### 1 Accounting policies

The principal accounting policies are summarised below. The accounting policies have been applied consistently throughout the year and in the preceding year.

#### (a) Basis of accounting

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention, and in accordance with the Statement of Recommended Practice - Accounting and Reporting by Charities (SORP 2005) issued in March 2005, applicable UK Accounting Standards, the Companies Act 1985 and the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective January 2005)

#### (b) Funds accounting

Funds held by the charity are

Unrestricted funds

these are available for use at the discretion of the trustees in furtherance

of the general objectives of the charity

Restricted funds

are subjected to restrictions on their expenditure imposed by the donor

or where funds have been raised for a specific purpose

#### (c) Incoming resources

All incoming resources receivable during the year are accounted for in the Statement of Financial Activities. The following specific policies are applied to particular categories of income

Voluntary income

includes donations and gifts of general nature and are recognised where there is entitlement, certainty of receipt and the amount can be measured with sufficient reliability

Incoming resources from charitable activities

includes income received under contract or where entitlement to grant funding is subject to specific conditions and is recognised as earned. Grant income included in this category provides funding to support performance activities and is recognised where there is entitlement, certainty of receipt and the amount can be measured with sufficient reliability.

#### (d) Resources expended

Expenditure is recognised on an accrual basis as a liability is incurred

Costs of generating funds

are those costs incurred in attracting voluntary income, and those incurred in

raising funds

Charitable activities

include expenditure associated with the production of theatrical performances and theatre / art workshops with community groups that include both the direct costs

and support costs relating to these activities

Governance costs

include those costs incurred in the governance of the charity and its assets and are primarily associated with constitutional and statutory requirements

Support costs

include central functions and have been allocated to activity cost categories to reflect the use of resources. Costs relating to a particular activity are allocated directly
