REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES

The trustees, who are directors of the Company for the purposes of Company law, present their annual report and financial statements for the year ended 31st December, 2008.

Objective and Organisation of the Charity

Rutland Sailability is a company limited by guarantee and is governed by its Memorandum and Articles of Association. It is a registered charity (No. 1069540) whose objects are the provision and maintenance of sailing and recreation facilities for the disabled. The Company is administered by its trustees and operates a club and sailing fleet at Rutland Water, within the Rutland Sailing Club, whose co-operation and support are greatly appreciated.

Review of the Charity's Activities

The Trustees are directors of the company and are elected by the members of Rutland Sailability at the Annual General Meeting. Listed below are the names of those trustees who have served during this year.

The year to 31st December, 2008 has again been very successful for the club. Members have had considerable sailing success on the water, at home and away. Club sailing has continued on Thursdays and Saturdays with Race Training on Mondays and Special Needs sailing on Fridays.

The Company's policy is to continue to improve the standard of boats and facilities provided for the use of its members. Rutland Sailability now has one of the best fleets and range of boats in the UK. The Trustees have agreed to replace several of the older boats in the fleet at a cost of approximately £16,000 and funds have been reserved in the accounts for this purpose. The conditions of the grants made to purchase the boats, and the terms of our constitution, require their return or passing on to another Sailability fleet should Rutland Sailability cease to function. They are therefore, totally depreciated in the accounts and not shown as assets of the company. As the boats are ageing a considerable programme of winter maintenance is being implemented for the fleet of boats, and provision has been made in the accounts for the cost of this.

The highlight of Rutland Sailability's year was the visit of Her Royal Highness the Princess Royal on 2nd December 2008. Princess Anne met and spoke with members of Sailability and Rutland County officials before unveiling a plaque to commemorate her visit.

The main operating income for Rutland Sailability is from local companies and organisations by way of donations and sponsorship. We are extremely grateful to the organisations that have provided the funds to purchase boats and equipment, and for the running costs of the fleet. Without these sponsors, the individual helper members of the club and the support of Rutland Sailing Club it would not be able to operate.

The company has no employees. The Trustees and helpers received no income or financial benefit from the company. The policy for the future is to continue to expand the facilities and to provide sailing enjoyment for more disabled members, and we look forward to the continuing support of our sponsors and all unpaid helpers alike

Controlling Interest

The control of the charity rests with the Trustees, whose names are shown on page 1. The Trustees meet on a monthly basis to administer the affairs of the charity.

Trustees and their interests

The trustees in office during the year are shown on page 1.

In accordance with the charity's Memorandum of Association each trustee gave a personal guarantee of £10.

Policy on Reserves

The charity's management committee consider that the general unrestricted reserves of £75,683 at 31st December 2008 is sufficient to sustain its operations should income generating activities be curtailed over the forthcoming year.

Risk Review

The charity's management committee have assessed the major risks to which the charity is exposed, in particular those related to the operations and finances of the charity, and are satisfied that the systems are in place to mitigate our exposure to the major risks.

Trustees' responsibilities

Company law requires the trustees to prepare financial statements for each financial period which gives a true and fair view of the state of affairs of the charity at the end of that period and of the net income or expenditure of the charity for that period. In preparing those financial statements. The trustees are required to:

select suitable accounting policies and then apply them consistently;

make judgements and estimates that are reasonable and prudent;

follow applicable accounting standards, subject to any material departures disclosed and explained in the financial statements;

prepare the financial statements on the going concern basis unless it is inappropriate to presume that the charity will continue in operation.

The trustees are responsible for maintaining proper accounting records which disclose with reasonable accuracy at any time the financial position of the charity and enable them to ensure that the financial statements comply with the Companies Act 1985. They are also responsible for safeguarding the assets of the charity and for taking reasonable steps for the prevention and detection of fraud and other irregularities.

ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparation

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention, and in accordance with applicable Accounting Standards and the Statements of Recommended Practice (SORP), "Accounting and Reporting by Charities" published in October 2000.

The charity has availed itself of Paragraph 3 (3) of Schedule 4 of the Companies Act and adapted the Companies Act formats to reflect the special nature of the charity's activities.

Incoming resources

Income represents donations, subscriptions and other funds generated from fundraising activities. All income was attributable to the United Kingdom.

Resources expended

All expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all costs related to the category.

Depreciation

Depreciation is provided on all tangible fixed assets at rates calculated to write off the cost, less estimated residual value of each asset over its expected useful life, as follows:

Equipment

Written off in the year of acquisition

General Funds

General funds are unrestricted funds which are available for use at the discretion of the trustees in furtherance of the general objectives of the charity and which have not been designated for other purposes.

Restricted funds

Restricted funds are funds which are to be used in accordance with specific restrictions imposed by donors or which have been raised by the charity for particular purposes.

The aim and use of the restricted fund is set out in the notes to the financial statements.

Designated funds

These are amounts which have been set aside at the discretion of the trustees for a specific, but not legally binding, purpose. The aim and use of the designated fund is set out in the notes to the financial statements.

Cash flow statements

The financial statements do not include a cash flow statement because the charity, as a small reporting entity, is exempt from the requirement to prepare such a statement under Financial Reporting Standard 1.

Taxation

No provision for corporation tax has been made as the company is a registered charity and is, therefore, not liable to taxation.
