1 Accounting policies

1 Accounting policies 1.1 Accounting convention The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention modified to include the revaluation of freehold land and buildings and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008). 1.2 Compliance with accounting standards The financial statements are prepared in accordance with applicable United Kingdom Accounting Standards (United Kingdom Generally Accepted Accounting Practice), which have been applied consistently (except as otherwise stated). 1.3 TurnoverTurnover represents amounts receivable for goods and services net of VAT and trade discounts. 1.4 Tangible fixed assets and depreciation Tangible fixed assets other than freehold land are stated at cost or valuation less depreciation. Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost or valuation less estimated residual value of each asset over its expected useful life, as follows: Land and buildings Freehold 2% Straight line Fixtures, fittings & equipment 25% Reducing balance 1.5 Revenue recognition Fee income represents revenue earned under a wide variety of contracts to provide professional services. Revenue is recognised as earned when, and to the extent that, the firm obtains the right to consideration in exchange for its performance under these contracts. It is measured at the fair value of the right to consideration, which represents amounts chargeable to clients, including expenses and disbursements but excluding value added tax. Fee income that is contingent on events outside the control of the firm is recognised when the contingent event occurs.
