Trustees' Report

Our Aims and objectives

Purposes and Aims

Our charity's purposes as set out in the objects contained in the company's memorandum of association are to promote environmental issues generally and the enhancement of the local environment in North Tawton.

The aims of our charity are to utilise, mprove and enhance the sites under our control for the benefit of wildlife, our members and the general public in our area. Our aims fully reflect the purposes that the charity was set up to further.

Ensuring our work delivers our aims

We review our aims, objectives and activities each year. This review looks at what we achieved and the outcomes of our work in the previous 12 months. The review looks at the success of each key activity and the benefits they have brought to the community we are set up to help.

The review also helps us ensure our aim, objectives and activities remain focused on our stated purposes. We have referred to the guidance contained in the Charity Commission's general guidance on public benefit when reviewing our aim and objectives and in planning our future activities. In particular, the trustees consider how planned activities will contribute to the aims and objectives they have set.

Who used and benefited from our services?

Our objects and funding limit the services we provide to our members, the local wildlife and residents of North Tawton.

Financial Review

Against the backdrop of limited resources and insecurities over funding, it has continued to be difficult to plan or develop services. The charity has used funds generated in previous years to provide environmental services in the current year.

Principal Funding Sources

Income is generated by the sale of water butts and compost bins.

Investment Policy

The majority of the funds are kept in the Charities Deposit Fund with a small amount required on a day to day basis kept in the bank current account.

Reserves Policy

The Management Committee has examined the charity's requirements for reserves in light of the main risks to the organisation. It has established a policy whereby the unrestricted funds not committed or invested in tangible fixed assets held by the charity should not fall below 12 months of normal expenditure. The present level of reserves available to the charity of £29,154 is therefore well above this target level.

Plans for Future Periods

We plan to continue our community growing project which teaches both young and older members how to grow produce in a chemical free and sustainable manner. Also to continue our involvement in the local plastic recycling operation.

Trustees' Report

The organisation is a charitable company limited by guarantee, incorporated on 7 September 1998 and registered as a charity on 12 July 1999. The company was established under a Memorandum of Association which established the objects and powers of the charitable company and is governed under its Articles of Association. In the event of the company being wound up members are required to contribute an amount not exceeding £10.

Recruitment and Appointment of Management Committee

The directors of the company are also charity trustees for the purposes of charity. All members of the Management Committee give their time voluntarily and receive no benefits from the charity. No expenses are reclaimed from the charity.

Trustee Induction and Training

Most trustees are already familiar with the practical work of the charity having been involved for many years.

Future plans and objectives.

Fundamental to our plans for future periods is the aspiration to retain our existing rented site as well as the site that we own. However, our rented site is under the ultimate control of our landlord so negotiations will continue.

Risk Management

The trustees have a duty to identify and review the risks to which the charity is exposed and to ensure the appropriate controls are in place to provide reasonable assurance against fraud and error.

1 Accounting policies

Basis of preparation

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Statement of Recommended Practice 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities (SORP 2005)', issued in March 2005, the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective January 2015) and the Companies Act 2006.

Fund accounting policy

Unrestricted income funds are general funds that are available for use at the trustees' discretion in furtherance of the objectives of the charity.

Further details of each fund are disclosed in note 14.

Incoming resources

Donations are recognised where there is entitlement, certainty of receipt and the amount can be measured with sufficient reliability.

Investment income is recognised on a receivable basis.

Income from charitable activities includes income recognised as earned (as the related goods or services are provided) under contract.

Resources expended

Liabilities are recognised as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to the expenditure. All expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all costs related to the category.

Charitable expenditure comprises those costs incurred by the charity in the delivery of its activities and services for its beneficiaries. It includes both costs that can be allocated directly to such activities and those costs of an indirect nature necessary to support them.

Governance costs

Governance costs include costs of the preparation and examination of the statutory accounts, the costs of trustee meetings and the cost of any legal advice to trustees on governance or constitutional matters.

Depreciation

Depreciation is provided on tangible fixed assets so as to write off the cost or valuation, less any estimated residual value, over their expected useful economic life as follows:

Plant and machinery

20% straight line basis

Stock

Stock is valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value, after due regard for obsolete and slow moving stocks. Net realisable value is based on selling price less anticipated costs to completion and selling costs. Items donated for resale or distribution are not included in the financial statements until they are sold or distributed.

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Operating leases

Rentals payable under operating leases are charged in the statement of financial activities on a straight line basis over the lease term.
