Because of the possible effect of the limitation in evidence available to us we are unable to form an opinion as to whether the financial statements

-give a true and fair view, in accordance with United Kingdom Generally Accepted Accounting Practice, of the state of the company's affairs as at 31 December 2009 and of its profit for the year then ended, and -have been properly prepared in accordance with the Companies Act 2006

The stock of property is shown at replacement cost in line with the alternative accounting rules embodied in the Companies Act 2006. The property was last formally valued by Drivers Jonas during the year ended 31 December 2007. Whilst there has been a downturn in the commercial property market since the last valuation date with falls in capital values across the market, due to volatility and a lack of comparable transactions it is difficult to quantify this precisely. In the opinion of the directors it is likely that the value of the stock of property has decreased by approximately 10%, though rental income stream remains intact and serviceability of debt is good. The historical cost of the properties is £1,625,459. Should the properties be sold for the revalued amount a liability to taxation would arise of approximately £385,000, this amount has not been provided for
