NOTES TO THE ACCOUNTS

1. Accounting Policy

These financial statements were prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standard 102, the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland ("FRS 102") as issued in August 2014 and amended in 2015 and 2016. As the Company has met the Companies Act 2006 definition of a dormant company as at and since the date of transition on 1 January 2014, the accounting policies applied at the date of transition under previous UK GAAP have been retained as permitted by paragraph 10(m), section 35 of FRS 102.
