Total time spent to 6 April 2012 on this assignment amounts to 35 75 hours at an average composite rate of £ 155 13 per hour resulting in total time costs to date of £5,545 75 Supervisor's fees of £4,500 have been drawn to date in accordance with the above approval leaving outstanding time costs of £1,045 75 Disbursements of £460.51 plus VAT have been incurred up to the anniversary but have not been drawn by the Supervisor leaving unbilled disbursements of £460 57 The following further information as regards time costs is set out at Appendix 2
