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Executive summary

- There a small number of residual matters, as detailed in this report, which are yet to be finalised. Therefore, the Administrators applied for and obtained a Court Order on 6 October 2010 to extend the remaining ten administrations for a further 12 months until 13 October 2011

- The Administrators considered the position of each of the remaining administrations separately
- Prior to making the application to extend the remaining ten administrations the Administrators advised the secured creditors of the intention to seek an extension to the administrations and received their support for this strategy
- The administrations have been extended for a further 12 months until 13 October 2011 for the following reasons

EG plc

- To dispose of the leasehold property at The Courtyard, Severn Drive Tewkesbury This property was under offer, but the purchaser recently withdrew from the sale. It is now back on the market
- To complete the collection of a debtor balance with a significant estimated realisable value by way of a joint collection exercise with a Caley owned entity
- As the parent company and the only entity with a bank overdraft facility,
 EG plc needs to remain open until all subsidiary company administrations have been closed

ECES

Following the approval of the Court of the Distribution Scheme to deal
with the client monies, and following expiry of a bar date for claims of 21
June 2010, £1 2m has been released to the estate of ECPS (£840,000
was received before 13 October 2010, with the balance received shortly
after) This has significantly increased the Prescribed Part available to its

The Administrators have sought legal advice on the treatment of investment assets in this entity to establish whether they should properly be treated as fixed or floating charge. Having made enquiries to determine the extent of security arrangements that were in place at the time that the investments were entered into, the Administrators have determined that certain of the securities were subject to a fixed charge and the others are floating charge assets on which a prescribed part is payable.

HLR, PR, ECS, EMS and Square Mile

A tax clearance process is in progress for the above companies and clearance is expected from HMRC shortly. Closure of these administrations will follow after ensuring no further liabilities remain outstanding and the final floating charge distributions have been made
