ORDER FOR THE RESTORATION OF A COMPANY

UPON THE APPLICATION by a Claim Form dated 24 August 2016 by Stephen John Hunt the Claimant and Liquidator of the aforenamed China Clearance Limited (hereafter called "the Company")

AND UPON READING the evidence

AND IT APPEARING that there is no opposition on behalf of Her Majesty to the relief sought by the Claim as appears from the waiver letter from the Treasury Solicitor dated the 4th October 2016

AND UPON hearing counsel for the Claimant

AND UPON the Court finding that the Claimant has standing to apply to restore the Company to the Register of Companies pursuant to Section 1029(2)(i) of the Companies Act 2006 and pursuant to Section 1029(2) of the Companies Act 2006 as "any other person appearing to the court to have an interest in the matter"

AND UPON the solicitors for the Claimant and for the Registrar of Companies (the Defendant) both consenting to this order

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- The name of China Clearance Limited be restored to the Register of Companies.
- 2. The Company do continue in Creditors' Voluntary Liquidation.
- The Claimant do serve a copy of the Order on the Company's former Liquidator within 21 days of the date hereof.
- 4. If at the date of registration of this Order with the Registrar of Companies the name of the Company is not available the Registrar of Companies shall pursuant to Section 1033(2)(a)(ii) and (b) of the Companies Act 2006 change the name of the Company to 03838681 Limited.
- An Office Copy of the Order be delivered to the Registrar of Companies and pursuant to above mentioned Act the Company is thereupon to be deemed to have continued in existence as if its name had not been struck off.

7. The Chimant do pay the Registrar of Companies his costs of the said Application in the 2 8 APR agreed sum of £300.

AND IT IS FUNTHER ORDERED BY THE COURT THAT:

- 8. The Claimant shall give notice of this Order to all creditors of the Company within 28 days of the date of this Order by way of advertisement in the "London Gazette". Any creditors wishing to apply to set aside or vary this Order to restore the Company shall apply on notice to the Claimant no later than 28 days after the date of the advertisement.
- 9. There be no Order as to costs save that the Claimant shall be entitled to charge the costs of this Claim as a cost or expense of the Company's estate (provided that any amount charged does not exceed 10% of the available funds of the Company's estate) only in the event that the Claimant makes additional recoveries of funds for the benefit of the Company's estate whilst acting as office holder of the Company.
