ORDER

UPON THE APPLICATION of Robert William Leslie Horton of R2 Advisory Limited, 27 Clements Lane, London, EC4N 7AE, made in his capacity as a Licenced Insolvency Practitioner and the proposed replacement liquidator in respect of the matters listed in the Schedules 1-4 appended hereto by application notice sealed on 12 December 2022 (the "**Application**")

AND UPON reading the evidence

AND UPON notice of the Application having been given to the Secretary of State

AND UPON the Court being satisfied that, pursuant to rule 12.38(1) of the Insolvency (England and Wales) Rules 1986, the Application can be considered without the need for a hearing

IT IS ORDERED THAT

1. REMOVAL OF MARK LEVY AS OFFICE-HOLDER

- 1.1 The First Respondent, Mark Levy, be removed from office as the Liquidator of the companies in Creditors Voluntary Liquidation detailed in Schedule 1 annexed hereto, with effect from the date of this Order, pursuant to section 108 of the Insolvency Act 1986 (the "IA 1986") and rule 12.36(2)(a) of the Insolvency (England and Wales) Rules 2016 (the "IR 2016").
- 1.2 The First Respondent, Mark Levy, be removed from office as the Liquidator of the companies in Members Voluntary Liquidation listed in Schedule 2 annexed hereto with effect from the date of this Order, pursuant to section 108 of the IA 1986 and rule 12.36(2)(a) of the IR 2016.

2. REMOVAL OF JEREMY HUGH BERMAN AS OFFICE-HOLDER

- 2.1 The Second Respondent, Jeremy Hugh Berman, be removed from office as the Liquidator of the companies in Creditors Voluntary Liquidation detailed in Schedule 3 annexed hereto with effect from the date of this Order, pursuant to section 108 of the IA 1986 and rule 12.36(2)(a) of the IR 2016.
- 2.2 The Second Respondent, Jeremy Hugh Berman, be removed from office as the Liquidator of the companies in Members Voluntary Liquidation listed in Schedule 4 annexed hereto with effect from the date of this Order, pursuant to section 108 of the IA 1986 and rule 12.36(2)(a) of the IR 2016.

3. APPOINTMENT OF ROBERT WILLIAM LESLIE HORTON AS REPLACEMENT OFFICE-HOLDER

- 3.1 Robert William Leslie Horton, having confirmed that he is qualified to act as the Licenced Insolvency Practitioner and that he consents to act in respect of the companies detailed in the Schedules annexed hereto, be appointed to replace Mark Levy and Jeremy Hugh Berman, as the office-holder in each of the matters set out in the Schedules.
- 3.2 Any act required or authorised under any enactment to be done by a liquidator may be done by Robert William Leslie Horton, as the replacement liquidator, of each company detailed in the Schedules.

4. ADVERTISEMENT, REPORTING TO CREDITORS AND MEMBERS AND RELEASE

- 4.1 The Applicant shall give notice of this Order to the creditors of the companies in Creditors Voluntary Liquidation listed in Schedules 1 and 3 and to the members of the companies in Members Voluntary Liquidation listed in Schedules 2 and 4, by:
- 4.1.1 Publishing a single block advertisement in the London Gazette within 28 days of this Order. Such advertisement shall include a notice that any creditor or member may, within 28 days of the advertisement, make an application to Court to set-aside or vary the terms of the Order. Such advertisement shall be published in substitution for notifying each individual creditor or member (as applicable) of each company listed in the Schedules, save to the extent provided for at the paragraph 4.1.2 below;
 - 4.1.2 Giving notice of the Order at the same time as the next routine report is due pursuant to statute or within twelve months following the making of this Order, whichever is sooner, such notice to contain the following matters:
 - 4.1.2.1 An explanation of the effect of this Order;
 - 4.1.2.2 In the case of liquidations, where liquidation committees of creditors' committees have been appointed, an explanation that, to the extent that any information which would otherwise be required to be provided has not already been provided as part of the report, it is open to that committee to require the Applicant to provide an account of the administration of the estate, including a summary of receipts and payments and a statement that they have reconciled the accounts;
 - 4.1.2.3 In the case of liquidations where no committees have been appointed, an explanation that, to the extent that such information as aforesaid has not already been provided as part of the report, it is open to any creditor to apply to court for an Order that the Applicant does provide an account of the administration of the estate, including a summary of receipts and payments and a statement that they have reconciled accounts;
 - 4.1.2.4 Notification that if the replacement office-holder has been required to provide the information referred to in 4.1.2.3 and 4.1.2.4 above, whether by a committee or by court order on the application of any creditor, the cost of the replacement office-holder of so complying will, unless there be good reason to the contrary, be paid as an expense of the liquidation; and
 - 4.1.2.5 In the case of liquidations, notification to each creditor of his right under regulation 11(2) of the Insolvency Regulations 1994 to require the replacement office-holder to supply a statement of receipts and payments free of charge.

- 4.2 In relation to the companies in the Schedules hereto, in so far as there is any requirement for any appointment or removal of an office-holder to be advertised, the requirement shall be dispensed with save to the extent provided for in paragraph 4.1.1 above.
- 4.3 The Applicant shall give notice to the Secretary of State and the Registrar of Companies in respect of the terms of this Order as soon as reasonably practicable following the making of this Order.
- 4.4 Permission is given to the Secretary of State to apply to vary this Order at any time up to 28 days after the notice referred to in paragraph 4.3 above is given.
- 4.5 The Applicant and Respondents be authorised to dispense with any requirement to file a progress report or a receipts and payments account in any of the cases set out in the Schedules hereto as a consequence of the removal of Mark Levy or Jeremy Hugh Berman and the replacement of Robert William Leslie Horton as an office-holder.

5. LIBERTY TO APPLY TO THE COURT

- 5.1 There be liberty to each creditor or member of each estate detailed in the Schedules hereto to apply to vary or discharge this Order within 28 days of receipt of the notices directed to be sent under paragraph 4.1 above.

6. SERVICE

- 6.1 Further service of the Application be dispensed with.
- 6.2 The Applicants shall serve a copy of this Order on the Secretary of State.

7. COSTS

- 7.1 No order as to costs.
