- The Joint Administrators be discharged from all liability pursuant to paragraph 98 of Schedule B1 of the Act upon the Joint Administrators filing of their final account
- The Company be wound up by the Court under the provisions of the Act,
 - 3a The EC Regulation in insolvency proceedings will apply and these are main proceedings as defined in Article 3 of the EC Regulation
- The advertisement of the Winding Up Petition in the London Gazette shall be dispensed with.
- 5 The Official Receiver be appointed as Liquidator;
- 6 The costs of the Winding Up Petition shall be costs in the liquidation and





7 The costs and expenses of the administration shall be paid out of the assets of the Company
