1. INTRODUCTION

I refer to the appointment of Simon Jagger and I as Joint Liquidators of the Companies on 16 January 2020.

This is my first report to the member following my appointment as Joint Liquidator.

The Companies' statutory information is detailed at Appendix II.

2. LIQUIDATORS' ACTIONS SINCE APPOINTMENT

The following actions have been undertaken since our appointment:

- Upon appointment, I arranged for the formal notices to be issued to the relevant parties,
- I declared an in-specie distribution to the member of the Companies on 31 March 2020,
- I liaised with the potential creditor claims, and
- I have liaised with HM Revenue & Customs (HMRC) in order to obtain pre-appointment taxation clearances.

The matters undertaken during the course of the solvent liquidation process have been statutory in nature and whilst there is no direct benefit to the member, the work has been completed under a fixed fee agreement.

3. RECEIPTS AND PAYMENTS

Attached at Appendix II are the receipts and payments accounts' for the Companies, for the period 16 January 2020 to 15 January 2021.

4. ASSETS

The Declaration of Solvencies indicated the Companies' only assets were intercompany debtors totalling £4.

The full value of the debtors in respect to each of the Companies were in-specie distributed to its member on 31 March 2020, leaving no further assets to realise.

5. LIABILITIES

There were no liabilities listed on the Declaration of Solvencies.

I advertised for creditor claims in the London Gazette and as a result no claims were received that were relevant to the Companies.

6. DISTRIBUTION TO THE MEMBER

On 31 March 2020, I distributed £4 in specie to the member of the Companies by way of a first and final distribution of capital at a rate of £1 per ordinary share to the member Spirit Group Equity Limited.

There will be no further distributions to the member.

7. JOINT LIQUIDATORS' REMUNERATION AND EXPENSES

Written resolutions of the member dated 16 January 2020 resolved that the Joint Liquidators' remuneration should be fixed at £1,875 plus VAT for each of the Companies for assisting with the preparation of the Declaration of Solvencies, and the winding up of the Companies. This payment has been made.

Any secured creditor may make a similar application to Court within the same time limit.

9. SUMMARY

All pre-liquidation tax returns have been submitted and we continue to liaise with HMRC in respect of receiving the relevant tax clearances. We are likely to experience additional delays as HMRC announced on 25th January 2021 the closure of all its helplines across its Debt Management's EIS teams until further notice. Due to current excessive demand HMRC have made the decision to redeploy staff from its Debt Management helplines to its COVID helplines and use any additional staff to clear existing backlogs. We will continue to communicate with HMRC by letter. This will impact in getting clearances from HMRC to allow

us to close the Liquidations. Once the necessary clearances have been received, the case can proceed to closure.
