1. Accounting policies

1.1. Accounting convention

1.3. Rent charges

Any deficit or surplus arising where the actual expenditure does not equal the budgeted expenditure is reflected in the accounts as an increase or decrease in the provisions for future maintenance and repairs

1.4. Taxation

The company is a mutually trading enterprise and any surplus or deficit arising as a result of the difference between the rent charges levied (based on budgeted costs) and actual costs incurred do not fall within the scope of corporation tax. Tax is levied on investment income only

2. Turnover

The total turnover of the company for the year has been derived from its principal activity wholly undertaken in the UK
