NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

For the 52 weeks Ended 30 October 2017

1. Accounting policies

1.1 Basis of preparation of financial statements

Bill and Brian Limited is a private limited company incorporated in the UK.

The company's registered address is 22 Henrietta Street, London, WC2E 8ND.

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical costs convention and in accordance with Financial Reporting Standard 102, the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the United Kingdom and the Republic of Ireland and the Companies Act 2006.

The preparation of financial statements in compliance with FRS 102 requires the use of certain critical accounting estimates. It also requires management to exercise judgment in applying the accounting policies (see note 2).

The following principal accounting policies have been applied:

1.2 Cash Flow

The company as a subsidiary of Maxwells Restaurants Limited, which prepares publicly available consolidated financial statements, is exempt from the requirement to prepare a cash flow statement under FRS102 1.12 (b).

1.3 Turnover

The turnover represents gross receipts from restaurant activities in the United Kingdom, exclusive of value added tax and intra management charges.

1.4 Tangible fixed assets

Tangible fixed assets under the cost model are stated at historical cost less accumulated depreciation and any accumulated impairment losses. Historical cost includes expenditure that is directly attributable to bringing the asset to the location and condition necessary for it to be capable of operating in the manner intended by management.

At each reporting date the company assesses whether there is any indication of impairment. If such indication exists, the recoverable amount of the asset is determined which is the higher of its fair value less costs to sell and its value in use. An impairment loss is recognised where the carrying amount exceeds the recoverable amount.

Depreciation is charged so as to allocate the cost of assets less their residual value over their estimated useful lives, using the straight-line method.

Depreciation is provided on the following basis:

Leasehold Property

- Over the length of the lease

Plant & machinery

- 5% to 33.33% straight line

The assets' residual values, useful lives and depreciation methods are reviewed, and adjusted prospectively if appropriate, or if there is an indication of a significant change since the last reporting date.

Gains and losses on disposals are determined by comparing the proceeds with the carrying amount and are recognised in the Statement of income and retained earnings.

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

1. Accounting policies (continued)

1.5 Stocks

Stocks are valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value after making due allowance for obsolete and slow-moving stocks. Cost include all direct costs and an appropriate proportion of fixed and variable overheads.

Net realisable value is based on estimated selling price less further expected cost expected to be incurred to completion and disposal.

1.6 Leasing

Rental payments under operating leases are charged to the profit and loss account on a straight-line basis over the period of the lease.

1.7 Deferred taxation

Full provision is made for deferred tax assets and liabilities arising from all timing differences between the recognition of gains and losses in the financial statements and recognition in the tax computation.

Deferred tax is not provided on timing differences arising from the revaluation of fixed assets in the financial statements.

A net deferred tax asset is recognised only if it can be regarded as more likely than not that there will be suitable taxable profits from which the future reversal of the underlying timing differences can be deducted.

Deferred tax assets and liabilities are calculated at the tax rates expected to be effective at the time the timing differences are expected to reverse.

Deferred tax assets and liabilities are not discounted.

1.8 Financial instruments

Financial instruments are classified and accounted for, according to the substance of the contractual arrangement, as either financial assets, financial liabilities or equity instruments. An equity instrument is any contract that evidences a residual interest in the assets of the company after deduction all of its liabilities.

1.9 Pensions

The company operates a defined contribution pension scheme and the pension charge represents the amounts payable by the company to the fund in respect of the 52 weeks.

2. Judgments in applying accounting policies and key sources of estimation uncertainty

Leasehold Property

Assets are stated at historical cost less accumulated depreciation and any accumulated impairment losses, as such there is a degree of judgement required as to wether any impairment charge is required.
