GUIDANCE TO PREPARING DORMANT COMPANY ACCOUNTS WHERE THE COMPANY'S ONLY TRANSACTION IS THE ISSUE OF SUBSCRIBER SHARES, AND THE COMPANY IS NOT A SUBSIDIARY: FOR FINANCIAL YEARS ENDING ON OR AFTER 26 JULY 2000.

- a. The attached template for dormant company accounts is only suitable for those companies which have never traded and where the only transaction entered into the accounting records of the company is the issue of subscriber shares.
- **b.** Shares may be fully paid, partly paid or unpaid: any paid element should be shown as "Cash at Bank and in hand", any unpaid element shown as "Called up share capital not paid".
- **c.** The first year's accounts should include note 1 (required by paragraph 39 of Schedule 4 to the Companies Act 1985), thereafter this note should be deleted.
- d. Dormant companies acting as an agent for any person must state that they have so acted in the notes to the accounts.
- **e.** A fee or penalty raised on the company for the payment of an annual return (form 363) fee, change of name fee, re-registration fee, or late filling penalty may be omitted from the company records and this DCA form if the payment was made by a third party without any right of reimbursement.
- f. The company directors are responsible for preparing and filing accounts at Companies House that comply with the requirements of the Companies Act and failure to do so may result in prosecution. Should you have any doubt about the company's entitlement to file dormant accounts, or the preparation of those accounts, you should seek professional advice.
- **g.** This guidance only advises on the preparation of abbreviated dormant accounts which can be filed at Companies House. It does not advise on the preparation of full accounts for the members.
