## TRUSTEES ANNUAL REPORT AND DIRECTORS REPORT FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31ST MARCH 2006

The directors present their report with the financial statements of the Trust for the year ended 31st March 2006.

#### **ACTIVITIES**

The Trust is a charitable company and its principal activity continues to be that of preserving, maintaining and enhancing for the benefit of the community at large the canals, rivers, their tributaries, waterways and natural environs of the Chelmer and Blackwater navigation conservation area.

#### DONATIONS AND INVESTMENT INCOME

Donations and investment income are accounted for on a received basis.

#### **GRANT INCOME**

Grant income is accounted for on a receivable basis.

#### RESOURCES EXPENDED

Resources expended are recognised in the period in which they were incurred. Resources expended include value added tax, which cannot be recovered.

#### ALLOCATION OF RESOURCES EXPENDED

Resources used are allocated to direct charitable expenditure on a specific basis or by an estimated apportionment where a cost is incurred in respect of more than one heading.

### ACHIEVEMENTS AND PERFORMANCE

The main areas of charitable activity are the provision of preserving, maintaining and enhancing the canals, rivers, their tributaries, waterways and natural environs, together with the education and understanding of the general public.

During the year, the Trust has been able to maintain and enhance, with the support of volunteers, the Chelmer and Blackwater navigation conservation area by clearing pennywort and refuse from the canal.

#### RISK REVIEW AND RESERVES POLICY

The trustees have conducted their own review of the major risks to which the Trust is exposed and systems have been established to mitigate those risks. Internal risks are minimised by the implementation of procedures for the authorisation of all transactions and projects and to ensure consistent quality of delivery of all activities. These procedures are periodically reviewed to ensure they continue to meet the needs of the organisation.

The information from the exercise has assisted in the setting of the reserves policies. It is policy that the reserves be maintained at a level considered by the board to be sufficient to ensure funds are available to meet liabilities without borrowing. It is considered that the current level of reserves remains sufficient to meet this.

## NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31ST MARCH 2006

### 1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

### Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Statement of Recommended Practice, Accounting and Reporting by Charities (SORP 2005) issued in October 2005, applicable accounting standards and the Companies Act 1985.

### Funding accounting

Unrestricted funds are available for use at the discretion of the trustees in furtherance of the general objectives of the charity.

Restricted funds are subjected to restrictions on their expenditure imposed by the donor or through the terms of an appeal.

#### **Incoming resources**

All incoming resources are included in the Statement of Financial Activities when the charity is entitled to the income and the amount can be quantified with reasonable accuracy. The following specific policies are applied to particular categories of income:

Income resources from grants, where related to performance and specific deliverables are accounted for as the charity earns the right to consideration by its performance.

Book sales are included as incoming resources within activities for generating funds when they are sold.

Investment income is included when receivable.

#### Resources expended

Resources expended are included in the Statement of Financial Activities on an accruals basis, inclusive of any VAT which cannot be recovered and is reported as part of the expenditure to which it relates:

Costs of generating funds comprises the costs associated with attracting voluntary income and the costs of selling books.

Charitable expenditure comprises those costs incurred by the charity in the delivery of its activities and services for its beneficiaries. It includes costs that can be allocated directly to such activities and those costs of an indirect nature necessary to support them.

Governance costs include those costs associated with meeting the constitutional and statutory requirements of the charity and include accountants fees and costs linked to the strategic management of the charity.

All costs are allocated between the expenditure categories of the Statement of Financial Activities on a basis designed to reflect the use of the resource. Costs relating to a particular activity are allocated directly; others are apportioned on an appropriate basis.
