LIQUIDATORS' REPORT TO BE PRESENTED TO THE FINAL MEETINGS OF THE COMPANY AND ITS CREDITORS

1. INTRODUCTION

Following my appointment as Liquidator of the above Company on 2 September 2010 this report sets out an account of my acts and dealings and of the conduct of the liquidation for the period from the date of my appointment to date.

2. RECEIPTS AND PAYMENTS

I attach for your information a copy of a recently prepared receipts and payments summary, the contents of which I trust you will find self-explanatory, and would comment as follows -

Book Debts

Following my appointment as Joint Liquidator, the company's debtor ledger was re-assigned to me from Santander Invoice Finance on 21 October 2010, with surplus funds of £16,876.22 being received.

At the date of the re-assignment the debtor ledger showed that the company had outstanding debtors amounting to £17,845.17.

I have realised £6,086.81, with the balance being written off as a result of various disputes and counterclaims and on receipt of evidence that payment had been made prior to our appointment

Cash at Bank

The sum of £11,809 02 was received from the closing balance held on the company's pre-liquidation bank account.

VAT Refund

The sum of £448 32 was received from HM Revenue & Customs in respect of a VAT refund due on the factoring agents fees.

Bank Interest

Due to funds being placed on an interest bearing account gross interest totalling £1 42 has been received

3. WORK UNDERTAKEN BY THE LIQUIDATOR DURING THE PERIOD

The majority of my time has been spent liaising with the company's director regarding company's assets, liabilities and company records and carrying out my statutory duties as liquidator.

4. INVESTIGATIONS

As liquidator I have a duty under the Company Directors Disqualification Act 1986 to make a confidential return to the Departments of Business, Innovation and Skills, Disqualification Unit on the conduct of all those persons who were directors of the company at the date of my appointment as liquidator or has been a director at any time in the preceding three years.

I can confirm that I have complied with my duty in this regard.

5. DIVIDEND TO CREDITORS

I have received claims totalling £7,346.97 from preferential creditors who have proved their debts in these proceedings.

I have also received claims totalling £418,694 29 from unsecured creditors who have proved their debts in these proceedings.

Pursuant to rule 11.7 of the Insolvency Rules 1986 no dividend has been declared to unsecured creditors as insufficient funds were realised.

6. LIQUIDATORS' REMUNERATION AND DISBURSEMENTS

Turning to my own costs in this matter, my remuneration as Joint Liquidator is based on computerised records of all time spent on the administration of this case. I attach a breakdown of my time costs in accordance with Statement of Insolvency Practice 9

You may recall that I was authorised to draw fees on a time cost basis and you will note from the above that I have drawn fees of £25,770.91 exclusive of VAT.

The Liquidators' disbursements have been drawn in accordance with the Creditors' Guide to Fees referred to below.

Creditors have a right to request further information from the Liquidator under Rule 4.49E of the Insolvency Rules 1986 and further have a right to challenge the Liquidator's remuneration and expenses under Rule 4.131 of the Insolvency Rules 1986.
