PROGRESS IN THE LIQUIDATION

Asset realisations

The receipts and payments account attached at Appendix C details the asset realisations in the liquidation.

As per the declaration of solvency, the only asset in the liquidation was £1 due from Group Companies. This has been distributed in specie to the Company's member.

No assets have been realised since our previous progress report.

HMRC

We are required to obtain clearances from both the Corporation Tax office, and the Enforcement & Insolvency Service which provides VAT and PAYE clearances, and which also issues HMRC's claim in respect of all taxes. I can confirm that all tax clearances were received in December 2022, though it should be noted that we were required to make numerous requests to HMRC as they have a backlog arising from the COVID-19 pandemic.

Accordingly, we took steps to commence closure of the liquidation, and issued our Proposed Final Account on 4 January 2023. Two weeks thereafter we were advised of an outstanding liability in respect of PAYE. Enquiries were made with the Company's parent group, British Telecommunications plc ('BT'), who then took steps to settle the liability. We then made numerous attempts to obtain confirmation from HMRC that they had received the funds, but we have received no response. Given that the parent group has confirmation of the payment they made and that we had previously received all tax clearances from HMRC, to avoid incurring further liquidation costs it has been agreed both internally and with the client that we proceed to close the liquidation.

Creditors

There were no known creditors, as per the Declaration of Solvency. However, on appointment we placed statutory advertisements in the London Gazette and Times newspapers inviting creditors to submit claims.

Unexpected claims totalling £39,108.78 and £46,192.80 were received in the liquidation, however it was confirmed that these liabilities had been transferred to BT and they have been settled accordingly.

As above, the PAYE claim referred to above has also been settled by BT.

Return on capital

On 4 January 2023, a first and final distribution of £1 per Ordinary Share in the Company was made to the member.

Other matters

In addition to the above matters, we have dealt with all statutory matters required by legislation and administrative work incidental to our duties as Joint Liquidators.

Joint Liquidators' remuneration

The Joint Liquidators' remuneration was approved on a time cost basis by the members.

Time costs of £11,113 to 31 July 2023 were incurred over 31 hours at an average rate of £356 per hour. Since our previous progress report, time costs of £3,452 have been incurred over 13 hours at an average rate of £276 per hour. The Joint Liquidators have not drawn any remuneration to date, and as the Company does not have any cash assets, the costs of the liquidation, including expenses, will be met by another group company.

A detailed report of the time incurred and a narrative of the work done since our previous progress report is attached in Appendix D.

Joint Liquidators' expenses

No expenses have been incurred and paid during the liquidation as shown in the receipts and payments account at Appendix C.

Release of the Joint Liquidators

Following receipt of confirmation from the Company's members that there were no queries on the conduct of the liquidation, the Joint Liquidators will vacate office and be released from liability on the delivery of the Final Account to the Registrar of Companies.

APPENDIX B

MEMBERS' RIGHTS

Within 21 days of receipt of the Proposed Final Account, members with at least 5% in value of the total voting rights of all members having the right to vote at general meetings of the Company or any member with the permission of court, may request in writing that the Joint Liquidators provide further information about their remuneration or expenses which have been itemised in the Proposed Final Account.

Within 14 days of receipt of the request, the Joint Liquidators must provide all of the information asked for, unless they think that:

- the time or cost in preparing the information would be excessive, or
- disclosure of the information would be prejudicial to the conduct of the liquidation or might reasonably be expected to lead to violence against any person, or
- they are subject to confidentiality obligations in respect of the information.

The Joint Liquidators are also required to give reasons for not providing all of the requested information.

Members with at least 10% in value of the total voting rights of all members having the right to vote at general meetings of the Company may, within eight weeks of receipt of the Proposed Final Account, make an application to court that the basis fixed for the Joint Liquidators' remuneration, the remuneration charged, or the expenses incurred by the Joint Liquidators, as set out in the Proposed Final Account, are excessive.
