1. <u>Introduction</u>

I was appointed Liquidator of the above company on 15 November 2017 at a meeting of the members and my appointment was confirmed by the creditors at a meeting held later on the same day.

Receipts and Payments

My Receipts and Payments account for the period 15 November 2017 to 14 November 2018 is attached which shows there have been receipts of £1,000 and payments of £883 plus vat giving a balance of £nil at the end of the year. I have incurred expenses of a Statutory bond (£30) and advertising (£253.80 plus vat) in the first year but do not have any funds to pay these costs as yet.

3. Assets

The sole asset is a debt for electricity which the directors showed as £4,000 of which they have to date paid £1,000.

4. Creditors

The sole known creditor is British Gas for the supply of electricity for which there has been correspondence but without much progress. There is currently no prospect of a dividend to creditors.

5. Liquidator's Remuneration

The basis of my remuneration was agreed at the first meeting of the creditors in accordance with Rule 4.127(2)(b) Insolvency Rules 1986, on a time costs basis. The total time costs of the Liquidator and his staff as at 13 November 2018 are £2,776, representing 10.3 hours at an average of £269.51 per hour. To date fees of £833 plus vat has been paid.
