The directors present their annual report with the accounts of the company for the year to 30th November 2006

Objects of the charity

The objects of the charity are to promote education of children, young persons and the general public and to improve the quality of life of all such persons by providing basketball and other sporting and recreation facilities for the community of Greater Manchester. To achieve this the company

- offers opportunities for a broad range of people to get involved in sporting activities
- provides facilities for both able and disabled people to be involved in sporting activities
- helps young people to develop their sporting abilities
- promotes sporting events to allow people in the area to watch sportsmen and women of higher ability perform

Organisation

The company is controlled by its board of directors which is made up of local people who are sympathetic to the activities of the charity

The company is limited by guarantee it therefore does not have a share capital and is governed by its Memorandum and Articles of Association. The directors have given a guarantee of £1 each in the event of the company winding up and are also trustees of the company for Charities Act purposes. There is a list of the directors on page 1.

None of the directors received any remuneration for their services to the company during the year

The company's aim is to generate sufficient income to meet the cost of running the sports centre. The directors are mindful of the need to continue to raise funds

Day to day operation of the sports centre has been delegated to Mr J Forber

Achievements and performance

The charity has continued to fulfil its objectives of developing participation in sport in the Greater Manchester area. The directors and trustees are grateful for the donations they continue to receive to allow their work to continue. The directors are constantly looking at ways of obtaining support for the charity.

Investment powers

Under the Memorandum and Articles of Association, the charity has the power to make any investment which the directors see fit

Risk management

The directors/trustees examine the major risks that the charity faces each financial year when preparing and updating their plans for the year ahead. They also monitor the risks and assess and control any impact that they may have on the charity in future

Reserves

At the year end the company's reserves were made up of the residue of the donations from John Amechi and the surplus from meeting its objectives. The cost of fulfilling its aims in the future will make it unlikely that the charity will build up extensive reserves

Accountants

1 Accounting policies

Basis of accounting

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention, and in accordance with the Statement of Recommended Practice, Accounting and Reporting by Charities (SORP) Accounting and Reporting by Charities, issued in 2005 and applicable accounting standards

Incoming resources

Income is accounted for in the year in which the service is provided

Donations and grants are included in incoming resources when these are receivable

Interest is included when receivable by the charity

Resources expended

Resources expended are included in the statement of financial activities on an accruals basis, inclusive of any VAT which cannot be recovered

Fixed assets

All expenditure on fixed assets is capitalised unless it is an item of repair, and fixed assets are stated at cost

Depreciation

In the case of fixtures, fittings and equipment, depreciation is provided in equal annual instalments to write off the cost of the assets over their anticipated useful lives. The annual rate used is 25%

Funds

Unrestricted funds are funds which the trustees are free to use in accordance with the charitable objectives
