#### IT IS ORDERED that:-

 Julian Guy Parr, Anthony Victor Lomas and Steven Anthony Pearson, (the "Outgoing Office-Holders") each be removed from office as administrator, nominee, supervisor or liquidator, as applicable, of the companies listed in Schedule 2 to this Order, to take effect on the fourteenth day after the date of this Order.

- The Outgoing Office-Holders each be replaced as office-holder in the case of each company listed in Schedule 3 of this Order by the respective Applicants named in the same Schedule, these replacements to take place on fourteenth day after the date of this Order.
- 3. For the companies listed at numbers (1) to (10) in Schedule 2 of this Order, in accordance with paragraph 100(2) of Schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986 (the "Act"), following Julian Guy Parr's, Anthony Victor Lomas' and Steven Anthony Pearson's resignations as administrators, all functions by:
  - a. Gillian Eleanor Bruce, Edward John MacNamara, Russell Downs and Derek Anthony Howell (in respect of companies (1) and (4) listed in Schedule 2 to this Order):
  - Gillian Eleanor Bruce, Edward John MacNamara, Russell Downs, Derek Anthony Howell and Ian David Green (in respect of companies (2) and (6) listed in Schedule 2 to this Order);
  - Dan Yoram Schwarzmann, Edward John MacNamara, Russell Downs and Gillian Eleanor Bruce (in respect of companies (3) and (5) and (8) to (9) listed in Schedule 2 to this Order);
  - d. Russell Downs, Julian Guy Parr, Edward John MacNamara and Gillian Eleanor Bruce (in respect of company (7) listed in Schedule 2 to this Order); and
  - e. Ian Christopher Oakley-Smith and Ian David Green (in respect of company (10) listed in Schedule 2 to this Order),
