1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective January 2007).

Turnover

Turnover represents the net amounts invoiced to customers during the period net of value added tax.

Deferred tax

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date.

Pension costs and other post-retirement benefits

The company operates a defined contribution scheme for two of the directors under which the pension costs charged against profits represent the amount of contributions payable to the scheme for the period.

Dividends

Dividends are recognised in the period in which they are declared.

3. ULTIMATE PARENT COMPANY

As at the year end Specsavers International Healthcare Limited was the ultimate parent company of Reading Visionplus Limited. Mr and Mrs Perkins have the controlling interest in the ordinary share capital of Specsavers International Healthcare Limited, the ultimate parent company. Specsavers International Healthcare Limited is a Guernsey registered company and its accounts are not available to the public.

The company's immediate parent company is Reading Specsavers Limited, a company registered in England & Wales.

4. RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS

During the year the company has conducted the following transactions with its ultimate parent company, Specsavers International Healthcare Limited and its subsidiaries, including Specsavers Optical Group Limited, its director. Specsavers Optical Group Limited is wholly owned by Specsavers International Healthcare Limited.

Sales £27,916 (2007: £33,208, Purchases of Goods £779,956 (2007: £797,240), Overhead Costs £179,395 (2007: £134,550) and Other Income £87,258 (2007: £86,581).

These transactions were made on an arms length basis during the normal course of trading and Specsavers International Healthcare Limited has confirmed that it will continue to provide these goods and services for the foreseeable future.

The balance with the Group Treasury Company is held with Specsavers Finance (Guernsey) Limited, a fellow subsidiary of Specsavers International Healthcare Limited. Specsavers Finance (Guernsey) Limited is incorporated in Guernsey and provides treasury services to the company and other Specsavers Group companies.

5. POST BALANCE SHEET EVENTS

Subsequent to the year ended 30 June 2008, the company proposed and paid a dividend on its Ordinary shares of £313,500 (2007: £289,000) to its immediate parent, Reading Specsavers Limited. These financial statements do not reflect this dividend, which will be accounted for in the shareholders' equity as an appropriation of retained earnings in the year ended 30 June 2009.
