Objectives and activities

The Association is established to promote the relief of distress and suffering, the rehabilitation, care and other needs of persons who are physically, sensorily or mentally disabled within the London Borough of Havering

The Association provides support, advocacy, information and training to member groups and people with disabilities and carers in Havering

Organisation

The Association is governed by the Trustees who meet regularly and are responsible for setting the strategic direction of the organisation and establishing policy. The day to day operation of the association is delegated to the Chief Executive.

REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31ST MARCH 2011

Review of the past year

During the year the Association continued to provide services to people with disabilities and carers and increased the services and training available

Use of assets

The Association's fixed assets consist of items set out in Note 6 to the Accounts

Dependence on particular donors

The Association is not dependent on regular donors

Significant events since the year end

There have been no events subsequent to the year end which would materially affect the Association's state of affairs at that date

Availability of assets

We believe that our assets are adequate to meet our obligations in the forthcoming year

Investment powers

Under the memorandum and articles of association, the Charity has the power to make any investment which the trustees see fit

Reserves policy

The trustees have established a policy whereby the unrestricted funds not committed or invested in tangible fixed assets ('the free reserves') held by the Charity should be not less than £60,000. At this level, trustees feel that they would be able to continue the current activities of the Charity in the event of a significant drop in funding. It would obviously be necessary to consider how the funding would be replaced or activities changed.

Public Benefit

With reference to the stated objects and activities, the trustees provide public benefit through the provision of information, advice, support, advocacy, befriending and day opportunities for people with disabilities and carers that live in the London Borough of Havering Referrals are received from Social Services, Primary Care Trusts, other voluntary sector organisations and self referral. It is the policy of the Association to provide services either free of charge or at a nominal rate. The fees charged are substantially below the costs incurred. The services provided by the Association are in line with the Prevention Agenda which means that people are less likely to need more intensive services from the NHS or Social Services. Public benefit is thus provided through the subsidy applied to the services offered by the organisation.

The trustees, are accordingly, able to confirm that they have complied with Section 4 of the 2006 Charities Act to have regard to guidance published by the Charity Commission

REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31ST MARCH 2011

Trustees' responsibilities in relation to the financial statements

Company law requires the trustees to prepare financial statements that give a true and fair view of the state of affairs of the Charity at the end of the financial year and of its surplus or deficit for the financial year. In doing so the trustees are required to

select suitable accounting policies and then apply them consistently,
