1. Accounting policies

Accounting convention

The accounts are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008)

Turnover

Turnover represents the amount derived from the provision of goods and services falling within the company's activities after deduction of trade discounts and value added tax

Goodwill

No amortisation is provided for goodwill Annual impairment reviews are carried out to assess the recoverable amount. Any impairment losses are recognised immediately in profit and loss

Tangible fixed assets and depreciation

Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost less residual value of each asset over its expected useful life, as follows

Leasehold property

Straight line over the life of the lease of 10 years

Plant and machinery

15% on written down value

Fixtures, fittings

and equipment Motor vehicles

10% on written down value

- 25% on written down value

Leasing and hire purchase commitments

Assets obtained under hire purchase contracts and finance leases are capitalised as tangible assets and depreciated over the shorter of the lease term and their useful lives. Obligations under such agreements are included in creditors net of the finance charge allocated to future periods. The finance element of the rental payment is charged to the profit and loss account so as to produce constant periodic rates of charge on the net obligations outstanding in each period.

Stock

Stock is valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value
