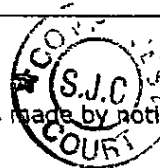

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**ORDER**

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**UPON** the application of the above-named Applicants made by notice dated 28 May 2012



**AND UPON** reading the documents recorded on the court file as having been read

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

- 1) The Creditors' Voluntary Liquidation of Lanos Limited (Company No. NI050693) listed in Schedule A is governed by The Insolvency (Northern Ireland) Order 1989 hereto shall be transferred to the Chancery Division of the High Court of Justice in London for the purposes only of making paragraphs 2 and 7 - 10, and 13 of this order.

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- 2) In relation to all the Creditors' Voluntary Liquidations set out in Schedule A hereto, the First Respondent be removed as joint liquidator, Paul Robert Boyle of Harrisons Business Recovery and Insolvency Limited and Harrisons Business Recovery and Insolvency (London) Limited of 4<sup>th</sup> Floor 25 Shaftsbury Avenue, London W1D 7EQ shall be appointed as joint liquidator on a joint and several basis and the Applicant shall continue in office as joint liquidator.
- 3) In relation to the Members' Voluntary Liquidation set out in Schedule B hereto, the First Respondent shall be removed as joint liquidator, Paul Robert Boyle shall be appointed as joint liquidator on a joint and several basis and the Applicant shall continue in office as joint liquidator.
- 4) In relation to the Compulsory Liquidations set out in Part I of Schedule C hereto, the First Respondent shall be removed as joint liquidator, Paul Robert Boyle shall be appointed as joint liquidator on a joint and several basis and the Applicant shall continue in office as joint liquidator
- 5) In relation to the Compulsory Liquidation set out in Part II of Schedule C hereto, the Second Respondent shall be removed as joint liquidator, Paul Robert Boyle shall be appointed as joint liquidator on a joint and several basis and the Applicant shall continue in office as joint liquidator.
- 6) In relation to the Administration set out in Schedule D hereto, the Third Respondent shall be removed as joint administrator, Paul Robert Boyle shall be appointed as joint administrator on a joint and several basis and the Applicant shall continue in office as joint administrator.
- 7) Notice of this order shall be given by the Applicant to each creditor of the liquidations, and administration particularised at Schedules A to D hereto by referring to this order in the next report or circular letter that is sent to the creditors
- 8) Notice of this order shall be given by the Applicant to the Secretary of State by sending a copy of this order by first class post within 7 days of the Applicant receiving a sealed copy of this order from the court.
- 9) There be liberty to each creditor of the liquidations and administration particularised at Schedules A to D hereto to apply to the court on notice to the Applicant to vary or discharge this order insofar as it may affect them, within 28 days of notice of this order being given.

- 10) In relation to the voluntary liquidations set out in Schedules A and B hereto, pursuant to rule 4.3 of the Rules, the prescribed period under rule 4.49C-CVL(7) of the Rules be extended to the end of 2 months after the end of the period to be covered by the subsequent progress report under rule 4.49C-CVL(3) of the Rules.
- 11) In relation to the compulsory liquidations set out in Schedule C hereto, pursuant to rule 4.49B(8) of the Rules, the period under rule 4.49B(7) of the Rules be extended to the end of 2 months after the end of the period to be covered by the subsequent progress report under rule 4.49B(5) of the Rules
- 12) In relation to the administration set out in Schedule D hereto, pursuant to rule 2.47(5) of the Rules, the period under rule 2.47(4) of the Rules be extended to the end of 1 month after the end of the period to be covered by the subsequent progress report under 2.47(3A) of the Rules.
- 13) The costs of and occasioned by this application shall be provided for and paid as a cost or expense of each of the liquidations and administrations listed in Schedules A to D hereto with each to bear an equal share.
