Notes to the Financial Statements for the Year Ended 31 March 2018

1. STATUTORY INFORMATION

Chichester Cathedral Restoration Trust Events Limited is a private company, limited by shares, registered in England and Wales. The company's registered number and registered office address can be found on the Company Information page.

2. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the provisions of Section 1A "Small Entities" of Financial Reporting Standard 102 "The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland" and the Companies Act 2006. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

The company is set up mainly to hold the biennial Festival of Flowers in order to raise funds for the Chichester Cathedral Restoration and Development Trust CIO (and its predecessor, the Chichester Cathedral Restoration and Development Trust), the company's parent undertaking. The surplus from this event (and any other events that may be held by the company) is passed to the parent undertaking by way of a gift aid donation and funds are not retained in the company. The next Festival of Flowers is due to be held from 31 May to 2 June 2018 and the loss for the year is principally due to expenditure incurred in preparation for the Festival of Flowers, whereas all the income received has been deferred to the following accounting period. The net liabilities position is therefore expected to be temporary and on this basis the directors consider that it is appropriate to prepare the accounts on the going concern basis.

Turnover

Turnover represents amounts received from fundraising, ticket sales and fees for the biennial Festival of Flowers. Turnover received in advance is not recognised unless there is no obligation to refund the amounts if the Festival of Flowers is cancelled.

Pension costs and other post-retirement benefits

The company operates a defined contribution pension scheme. Contributions payable to the company's pension scheme are charged to profit or loss in the period to which they relate.

Expenditure

Expenditure represents amounts paid for putting on the biennial Festival of Flowers. Expenditure in advance is recognised when the liability arises unless it is refundable in the event that the Festival of Flowers is cancelled.
