## Schedule 1 Short Particulars of all the Property Charged

### Assignments, Fixed and Floating Charges

In the Debenture the Charging Company:

"Fee Letter" means any letter or letters dated on or about the date of the Senior Facilities Agreement between The Royal Bank of Scotland plc as the arranger and the Charging Company (or the Agent and the Charging Company or the Trustee and the Charging Company) setting out any of the fees referred to in clause 16 of the Senior Facilities Agreement and any other agreement setting out fees referred to in clause 9.5 of the Senior Facilities Agreement.

whether held directly by or to the order of the Charging Company or by any trustee, nominee, fiduciary or clearance system on its behalf and all Related Rights (including all rights against any such trustee, nominee, fiduciary or clearance system).

"Monetary Claims" means any book and other debts and monetary claims owing to the Charging Company and any proceeds thereof (including any claims or sums of money deriving from or in relation to any Intellectual Property, any Investment, the proceeds of any Insurance Policy, any court order or judgment, any contract or agreement to which the Charging Company is a party and any other assets, property, rights or undertaking of the Charging Company).
