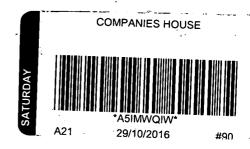

Group Strategic Report for the Year Ended 31 December 2015

The directors present their strategic report of the company and the group for the year ended 31 December 2015.

REVIEW OF BUSINESS

The group maintained the number of hotels published on its website at around 1,000 in the year and launched a new private luxury villa collection. It acted as an agent on approximately 64,000 hotel bookings and the group's revenues grew by 27%.

The key performance indicators used by the directors to monitor the progress of the group are set out below:

There is also a foreign exchange loss included in the consolidated other comprehensive income for the year amounting to £24,383. This primarily relates to the translation of the balances on the inter-company loans to the overseas subsidiaries at the exchange rates ruling at the year-end.

The directors consider the results to be satisfactory given the growth of the group, the exceptional nature of some of the factors the company has faced during the period and the general economic climate in which the company has and continues to operate.

Research and development

The group continually researches new hotels and villas to publish information on and continuously develops its proprietary booking technology to act as an agent for hotels.

Future developments

The strategic aim of the group for 2016 and 2017 is to consolidate the existing hotel and villa business and focus on driving growth through customer service and retention.

PRINCIPAL RISKS AND UNCERTAINTIES

Financial instrument risk

Up to 31 December 2015, Smith Bonds Plc, one of the group's wholly owned subsidiaries, had issued £2,463,000 of four year unsecured bonds paying an annual interest of 7.5% in cash or 9.5% in Smith loyalty money.

Also, the group is exposed to translation and transaction foreign exchange risk. However, the group has a lot of inbuilt hedging with both revenues and costs in multiple currencies. Revenues include annual fees paid by around 1,000 hotels around the world, paid in currencies of the group's choice (e.g. GBP, EUR, USD, AUD), plus booking prepayments from bookers all over the world and invoiced commissions from the global hotels. Costs include marketing and hotel account management operations in GBP, EUR, USD, AUD and HKD and booking payments to the global hotels, in both cases largely matching with the revenues received.

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standard 102 "The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland" and the Companies Act 2006. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Basis of consolidation

The consolidated income statement and balance sheet include the financial statements of the company and its subsidiary undertakings made up to 31 December 2015. Intra-group sales, profits and inter-company balances are eliminated fully on consolidation.

Turnover

Revenue is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable, excluding discounts, rebates, value added tax and other sales taxes.

Turnover represents the commission/margin earned on all hotel and associated arrangements sold, recognised on the date of stay basis, and the publishing of hotel information and invoicing of membership fees, recognised over the period they relate to, net of value added tax.

Turnover is attributable to one continuing activity.

Total transaction value (TTV) is the total gross amount receivable by the hotels in respect of booking arrangements made through the company for the year. Application Note G to FRS 5 requires the statutory turnover to be the net commission/margin earned. TTV for the year ended 31 December 2015 was £54,455,333 (2014 - £42,207,806).

Trade debtors still represent gross amounts receivable in respect of hotel arrangements and publishing and membership sales, and trade creditors still represent gross amounts payable in respect of hotel arrangements and publishing and membership purchases.

Intangible fixed assets

Intangible fixed assets are measured at cost less accumulative amortisation and any accumulative impairment losses.

Website development 20% on cost Intellectual Property 20% on cost

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Short leasehold over the lease term
Plant and machinery 25% on cost
Fixtures and fittings 25% on cost
Image library 25% on cost

Stocks

Stocks are valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value, after making due allowance for obsolete and slowing moving items.

Deferred tax

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date.

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES - continued

Research and development

The company and group has developed a sophisticated booking engine to process information from hoteliers, and a search engine to help customers find the hotels that suit their requirements. Directly attributable and ascertainable research and development costs in respect of this and other related projects have either been expensed in the income statement or capitalised by the company as intangible fixed assets. The intangible fixed assets attributable to the research and development are being amortised over their estimated economic life of 5 years. The amortisation is being charged to the income statement.

Foreign currencies

Assets and liabilities in foreign currencies are translated into sterling at the rates of exchange ruling at the balance sheet date. Transactions in foreign currencies are translated into sterling at the rate of exchange ruling at the date of transaction. Exchange differences are taken into account in arriving at the operating result.

Hire purchase and leasing commitments

Rentals paid under operating leases are charged to profit or loss on a straight line basis over the period of the lease.

Pension costs and other post-retirement benefits

The group operates a defined contribution pension scheme. Contributions payable to the group's pension scheme are charged to profit or loss in the period to which they relate.

2. REVENUE

The revenue and profit (2014 - loss) before taxation are attributable to the one principal activity of the group.
