1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

(a) Accounting basis and standards.

The accounts are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective June 2005).

(b) Turnover

Turnover represents the invoiced value of goods sold/services provided net of value added tax.

(c) Fixed assets and depreciation

Fixed assets are stated at cost less depreciation.

Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost of fixed assets, less their estimated residual value, over their expected useful lives on the following bases:
