STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

Governing Document

The organisation is a charitable company limited by guarantee, incorporated on 3 July 2002 and registered as a charity on 27 May 2003. The company was established under a Memorandum of Association which established the objects and powers of the charitable company and is governed under its Articles of Association. In the event of the company being wound up members are required to contribute an-amount not-exceeding £10.--

TRUSTEES ANNUAL REPORT (continued)

Recruitment and Appointment of Directors and Trustees

The directors of the company are also charity trustees for the purpose of charity law and under the company's Articles of Association are known as Trustees. Under the requirements of the Memorandum of Association one third of the trustees are required to retire at each annual general meeting by rotation. They may be re-elected by the remaining trustees.

The trustees may appoint a person who is willing to be a trustee wither to fill a vacancy or as an additional trustee.

Risk Management

The trustees are conducting a review of the major risks to which the charity is exposed. A risk register has been proposed and will be updated at least annually. Where appropriate, systems or procedures have been established to mitigate the risks faced by the charity.

Honorary President

Mrs Marjorie Ziff is the Honorary President.

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

The Company has set two main objectives for the charity, these are:-

- (1) To promote the preservation, restoration, maintenance and improvement of Roundhay Park Leeds for the benefit of the public.
- (2) To promote the benefit of Leeds and the surrounding areas by associating the local authorities and inhabitants in a common effort to provide facilities in the interest of social welfare for recreation and leisure time occupation with the objects of improving the conditions of life for the inhabitants.

ACHIEVEMENTS AND PERFORMANCE

During the year, the Charity has continued to make improvements in the Park in those areas which are generally not dealt with by the Park Staff.

The Geology Trail is well supported and escorted walks for the general public are now a regular event. Sales of the Trail Leaflet have slowed down, but there is still a small demand.

Work has continued in The Ravine and large undergrowth clearances have been done alongside the meadow below the Castle. There has been a breakthrough with Leeds City Council, in that some Members have achieved Certification to use strimmers and mowers in the Park, which will make the Working Parties much more effective.

Regular maintenance of The Friends' Garden continues and the Garden has proved to be a tremendous success as far as Park visitors are concerned.

The Lester Library official opening was held on the 10th January 2009 and was attended by members of The Lester Family. The Library is currently opening weekly and this will be constantly reviewed.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

The charity has made a surplus on its general activities of £2,003 (2008: deficit £644). The charity has spent £6,833 of the restricted Lester donation in the year. The unrestricted and restricted funds now stand at £5,626 and £667 respectively (2008: £4,633 and £7,500).

Reserves Policy

The trustees have examined the charity's requirements for reserves in light of the main risks of the organisation. It has established a policy whereby the unrestricted funds of the charity should be a minimum of 6 months based on the budgeted expenditure for the following year. The budgeted expenditure for 2009/10 is anticipated to be £3,000.

Investment Powers and Restrictions

The directors/trustees are only permitted to use the charity's assets solely towards the promotion of the objectives of the charity.

PLANS FOR FUTURE PERIODS

The Lester Donation received in 2008 has been expended with the remaining £667 to be used to purchase additional books in 2009/10.

Other funds will be used for purchasing plants, tools and materials to maintain areas improved by FORP and other areas yet to be identified

RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE TRUSTEES

The trustees are responsible for preparing the Trustees Annual Report and the financial statements in accordance with applicable law and regulations.

Company law requires the trustees to prepare financial statements for each financial year. Under that law the trustees have elected to prepare the financial statements in accordance with United Kingdom Generally Accepted Accounting Practice (United Kingdom Accounting Standards and applicable law). The financial statements are required by law to give a true and fair view of the state of affairs of the charity and of the surplus or deficit of the charity for that period.

In preparing these financial statements, the trustees are required to:

- select suitable accounting policies and then apply them consistently;
- · make judgements and estimates that are reasonable and prudent;
- prepare the financial statements on the going concern basis unless it is inappropriate to presume that the charity will continue in operation.

The trustees are responsible for keeping proper accounting records which disclose with reasonable accuracy at any time the financial position of the charity and which enable them to ensure that the financial statements comply with Companies Act 1985. The trustees are also responsible for safeguarding the assets of the charity and hence for taking reasonable steps for the prevention and detection of fraud and other irregularities.

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of accounting

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with applicable United Kingdom accounting standards, the Statement of Recommended Practice "Accounting and Reporting by Charities" issued in March 2005 (SORP 2005) and the Companies Act 1985.

Cash flow statement

The trustees have taken advantage of the exemption in Financial Reporting Standard No 1 (revised) from including a cash flow statement in the financial statements on the grounds that the charity is small.

Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds are available for use at the discretion of the trustees in furtherance of the general objectives of the charity.

There are no other funds.

Incoming resources

All incoming resources are included in the statement of financial activities when the charity is entitled to the income and the amount can be quantified with reasonable accuracy.

Fund accounting

The Lester donation has been put into a restricted fund and it is restricted to the objectives as set out by the Lester family.

Resources expended

All costs are allocated between the expenditure categories of the SoFA on a basis designated to reflect the use of the resource.

Fixed assets

All fixed assets are initially recorded at cost.

Stocks

Stocks are valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value, after making due allowance for obsolete and slow moving items.
