1 Introduction

- 1.1 I, Jeffrey Mark Brenner of B&C Associates Limited, Concorde House, Grenville Place, Mill Hill, London, NW7 3SA, was appointed as Liquidator of Wheeler Limited (the Company) on 22 July 2020. 2 Receipts and Payments

2.1 At Appendix A, I have provided an account of my Receipts and Payments for the Period with a comparison to the director's Declaration of Solvency, together with a cumulative account since my appointment, together with details of the remuneration charged and expenses incurred and paid by the Liquidator.

3 Work undertaken by the Liquidator

- 3.1 This section of the report provides members with an overview of the work undertaken in the liquidation since the date of my last progress report, together with information on the overall outcome of the liquidation.
- 3.2 The time spent on this case relates to the following matters:

 - A final distribution of £2,098.80 on 20 October 2021

6 Liquidator's Remuneration

- The member approved that the basis of the Liquidator's remuneration be a fixed fee in the sum of £6,000 plus VAT and expenses.
- 6.2 The Liquidator has drawn £6,000 against the total set fee agreed of £6,000 approved by the member.

7 Conclusion

- 7.2 In addition, that members with at least 10% of the total voting rights of all the members having the right to vote at general meetings of the Company may within 8 weeks of receipt of this progress report, make an application to court on the grounds that, in all the circumstances, the basis fixed for the Liquidator's remuneration is inappropriate and/or the remuneration charged, or the expenses incurred by the Liquidator, as set out in this report, are excessive.
- 7.3 The members have waived this requirement by confirming that they do not intend to raise any objection, which enables me to issue this Final Account without delay. Consequently, I will vacate office and obtain my release on the Final Account being filed with the Registrar of Companies
