The Board of Trustees present their report and the independently examined financial statements of the company for the year ended 31 July 2004. Under the Articles of Association the directors of the company are the members of the Board of Trustees

CHARITY DESCRIPTION AND OBJECTIVES

The company is limited by guarantee statements and is registered as a charity (Registered No 1095555).

The company's main objectives are to promote the relief of older people and disabled people including assisting and co-operating in the work of statutory authorities and voluntary organisations engaged in providing facilities for physical and mental recreation, developing physical and mental recreation, developing physical improvements, furthering health, relieving poverty, distress and sickness.

REVIEW OF OPERATIONS

The second year of operation has seen extensive development of the existing domestic support service and diversification into new areas of training and consultancy.

The Domestic Support Service continues to grow from strength to strength, the demand securing future permanent positions in management and staff delivering the service. New partnership arrangements with Guideposts Trust have enabled the service to extend not only to older people but also people with physical and learning disabilities. The partnership will enable the service to be developed in other parts of the country.

Training and consultancy has involved delivering employment law updates relating to the recently implemented provisions of the Employment Act 2002 to a large multinational organisation at depots throughout the country.

Jubilee Citizens UK was commissioned by the National Care Standards Commission (now the Commission for Social Care Inspection) to facilitate service user consultation events in London, Birmingham and Leicester which brought together older people from many different cultural backgrounds. Feedback from the events confirmed their success, enlightening older people in relation to their knowledge and understanding of the functions of the National Care Standards Commission and the rights they have as older people in regulated care.
