For the avoidance of doubt, the Respondent will remain in office as the supervisor of the individual voluntary arrangements of each of the individuals listed in Schedule E to this Order, and will hold office jointly together with the Successor Practitioner (such appointment to be joint and several).
17. The Applicant be removed from the office of administrator of the company listed in Schedule F to this Order with immediate effect.
18. The Successor Practitioner be appointed as the administrator of the company listed in Schedule F to this Order in place of the Applicant with immediate effect.
19. For the avoidance of doubt, the Respondent will remain in office as the administrator of the company listed in Schedule F to this Order, and will hold office jointly together with the Successor Practitioner (such appointment to be joint and several).
20. The Applicant be removed from the office of liquidator of the company listed in Schedule G to this Order with immediate effect.
21. The Successor Practitioner be appointed as the liquidator of the company listed in Schedule G to this Order in place of the Applicant with immediate effect.
22. For the avoidance of doubt, the Respondent will remain in office as the liquidator of the company listed in Schedule G to this Order, and will hold office jointly together with the Successor Practitioner (such appointment to be joint and several).

Notwithstanding the removal of the Applicant and the appointment of the Successor Practitioner as trustee in bankruptcy of the individuals listed in Schedule A to this Order, any progress reports that are filed in relation to each of these individuals will continue to cover the period specified in Rule 6.78A(3) of the Insolvency Rules 1986.

24. Notwithstanding the removal of the Applicant and the appointment of the Successor Practitioner as the liquidator of the company listed in Schedule B to this Order, any progress reports that are filed in relation to this company will continue to cover the period specified in Rule 4.49B(4) of the Insolvency Rules 1986.
25. Notwithstanding the removal of the Applicant and the appointment of the Successor Practitioner as liquidator of the companies listed in Schedules C and G to this Order, any progress reports that are filed in relation to each of these companies will continue to cover the period specified in Rule 4.49C-CVL(2) of the Insolvency Rules 1986.
26. Notwithstanding the removal of the Applicant and the appointment of the Successor Practitioner as administrator of the company listed in Schedule F to this Order, any progress reports that are filed in relation to this company will continue to cover the period specified in Rule 2.47(3) of the Insolvency Rules 1986.
27. The Successor Practitioner do give notice of his appointment to all creditors of the estates listed in Schedules A to G to this Order within 28 days of the date of this Order by way of advertisement in the London Gazette.
28. All creditors of the estates listed in Schedules A to G to this Order do have permission to apply to the Court, on notice to the Applicant and the Successor Practitioner, within 28 days of the advertisement referred to in paragraph 27 of this Order for the purposes of applying to vary or discharge the Order in so far as it affects the estate or estates of which they are a creditor
29. The time for service of the Application Notice upon the Respondent be abridged.
30. There be no Order as to costs save that the Applicant's costs of this application be charged as a cost or expense of the estates listed in Schedules A to G to this Order (each estate to bear an equal share, but with no estate having to bear an amount exceeding 10 per cent of the available funds in that estate).
31. Permission to apply.

AND IT IS ORDERED THAT:

32. The total sum of the costs to be charged as a cost or expense of the estates listed at Schedules A to G of this Order pursuant to paragraph 30 above be £5,800.
