Structure, governance and management

The Food & Shelter Foundation is a charitable company limited by guarantee, incorporated on 14 November 2002 and registered as a charity on 7 March 2003, Charity Number 1096411, Company Number 04590133

As the company is limited by guarantee and has no share capital, the financial interests of the director of the Trust are identical to those of the members

Objectives and activities

The objective of the company is to carry on as a non-profit making body in particular to relieve poverty, advance education, preserve and protect health worldwide

Achievements and Performance

This year Food and Shelter Foundation has worked in two African countries namely Gambia and Zimbabwe. In Gambia the foundation has grouped its resources with a British Charity, CBC Charitable Trust, who have people working on the ground to administer various humanitarian projects. The foundation has also been working with Local Zimbabwean charities to assist the local people with aid.

The following is a brief summary of the achievements and performance

- During the year we have assisted towards the relief of poverty, sickness and distress of persons who
 are in conditions of need and hardship by providing food, clothing, accommodation and financial
 assistance in Gambia, West Africa
- We have progressed in providing facilities for advancing the education of children and providing teachers in needed communities in the Gambia
- We have also provided funding for the construction of a Health Centre/Clinic for a much needed community providing support services and facilities to the Latrikunda Health Centre, Gambia, West Africa

The foundation has also been on an ongoing basis been providing funds for the orphaned and poor children within Palasteine through the British Charity Interpal Reports of the progress of this are regularly received

The foundation has also contributed to a religious organisation for the construction of premises which was in need of repair. Work was completed in June 2008

In Zimbabwe we have provided 500 families with monthly food supplies and due to the political and economic situation in the country this aid could not be continued as there were restrictions on the amount of food an Organisation or individual could buy

In order to circumvent the foundation aided projects, families were provided with education to rear chicken so that they can now provide for their family by selling the produce

Fund raising

The general fund represents donations received from UK companies

Disbursement of funds

During the year £95,390 was donated to worthwhile causes, which is split as follows

Relief of poverty

£54,630

Education

£40,760

The director and trustees endeavour to distribute all income received in the year to charitable causes

The management committee aim to ensure any major risks facing the trust are identified and steps taken where appropriate to mitigate them
