Accounting Policies

Basis of Accounting - The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective January 2007)

Depreclation - Fixed assets are depreclated at the following rates in order to write off the cost of the assets over their anticipated useful lives

Deferred taxation is measured on a non-discounted basis at the average tax rates that would apply when the timing differences are expected to reverse, based on tax rates and laws that have been enacted by the balance sheet date
