NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

(a) BASIS OF PREPARATION OF FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention and include the results of the company's operations, which are described in the Directors Report and all of which are continuing. The financial statements have been prepared on a going concern basis. This may not be appropriate because at 30th November 2008 the company's current liabilities exceeded its current assets by £8097 and total liabilities of the company were £11326. The company is reliant upon the continued support of its directors, bank and creditors, but there is no evidence to suggest that this will not continue and that further funds will not be provided as necessary, to enable the company to continue as a going concern. (b) TURNOVER

Turnover comprises the invoiced value of goods and services supplied by the company, excluding VAT and trade discounts.

(c) TANGIBLE FIXED ASSETS AND DEPRECIATION

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost less depreciation.

Depreciation is provided on all tangible fixed assets at rates calculated to write-off the costs less estimated residual value of each asset evenly over their expected useful lives as follows:

- 25% straight line

(d) DEFERRED TAXATION

The charge for taxation takes into account taxation deferred as a result of timing differences between the treatment of certain items for taxation and accounting purposes. In general, deferred taxation is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date. However, deferred tax assets are recognised only to the extent that the directors consider that it is more likely than not that there will be suitable taxable profits from which the future reversal of the underlying timing differences can be deducted. Deferred taxation is measured on a non-discounted basis at the tax rates that are expected to apply in the periods in which the timing differences reverse, based on tax rates and laws enacted or substantively enacted at the balance sheet date.

(e) CASH FLOW STATEMENTS

The company, being a company of small size within the meaning of the Companies Act 1985, has used the exemption provided by Financial Reporting Standard No:1 under which they are not required to include a cash flow statement as part of their financial statements.

(f) FOREIGN CURRENCIES

Monetary assets and liabilities in foreign currencies are translated into sterling at the rates of exchange ruling at the balance sheet date. Transactions in foreign currencies are translated into sterling at the rate ruling on the date of the transaction. Exchange differences are taken into account in arriving at the operating profit.
